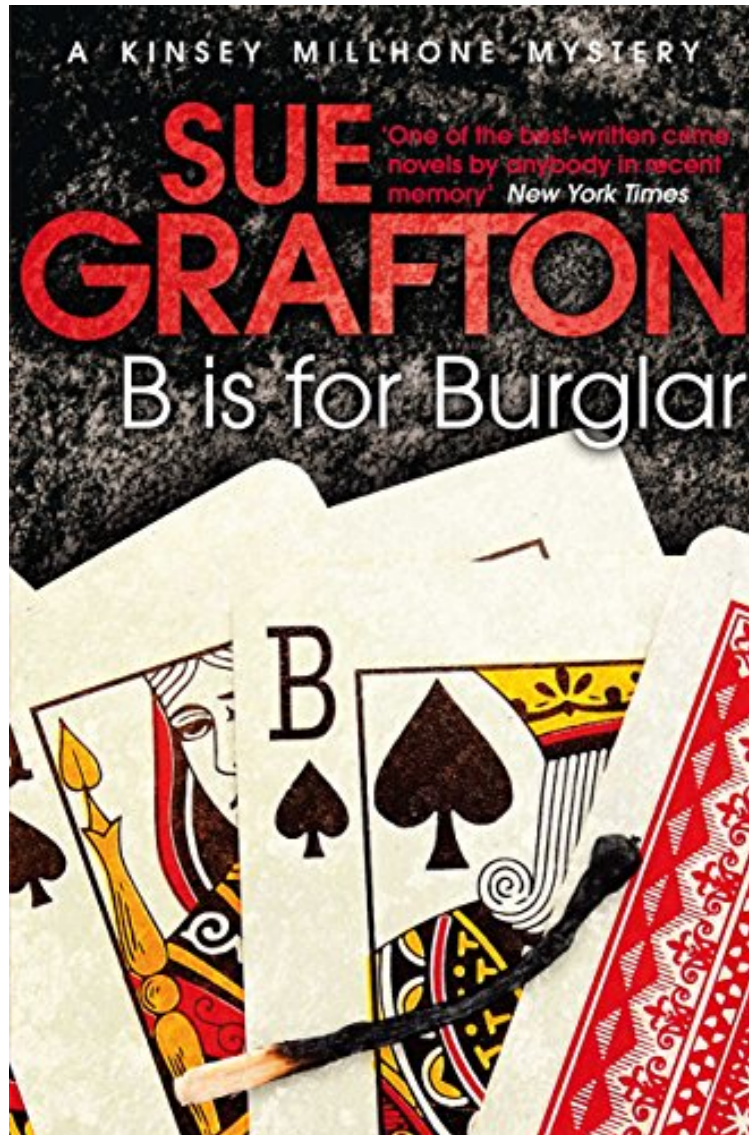

This deserves its two awards for one reason: the ending is so damn twisted. i am a dire fan of irony and Kinsey Millhone offers plenty of it, especially in her first few novels. All of the clues are carefully hidden and spread out, put skillfully into casually conversations that have nothing (or seem to have nothing) with the plot itself. It doesn't get five stars for one tiny reason: at the beginning, the pacing was a little slow. it really picks after a while, but it takes time. But that's really just nick-picking.
