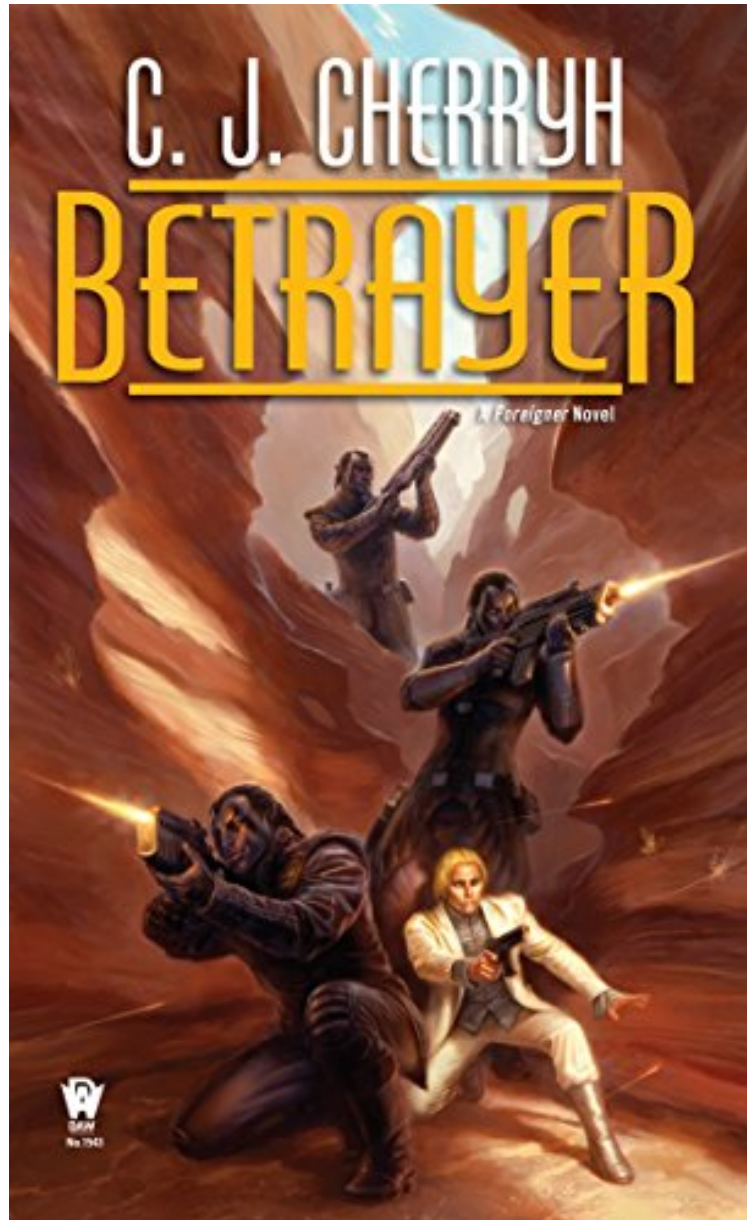

Bren Cameron, with two, sorry three more books already published as I write this. As with most of the other books of this series, I thoroughly enjoyed reading this book, but for me this is almost a guilty pleasure. I have a deep suspicion of apparently never-ending series, as they tend to lose their way and seem to go nowhere plotwise. While Ms Cherryh mostly avoids this problem, the Bran Cameron books are certainly a meandering, widespread saga of plots and conspiracies. (One definitely should not start reading the series at this point. I doubt if anyone would catch up with what has been going on before despite the frequent references to previous events.) I find myself thoroughly engrossed in the books, reading them with great pleasure. At the same time I am on occasion getting rather tired of endless, or at least extremely long sections, of pondering about the situation and long expositions of what is happening in dialogue. I do very much like the characters as they are presented, and at the same time, occasionally get irritated because it has become all a bit predictable. By now, I also know that none of the really important people will ever get killed. Which on the one hand is quite comforting, but on the other hand reduces the tension significantly. "Betrayal" was a book I enjoyed reading enormously, notwithstanding these points of criticism. It's what I call my popcorn literature.

Bren Cameron sitzt mit seinen Atevi-Bodyguards im Marid-District fest und muss versuchen, mit seinem ganzen diplomatischen Geschick eine Begegnung mit Machigi, dem Lord der Taisigin Marid, zu treffen. Das politische Überleben von Tabini-Aishi und der Western Association steht ebenso auf dem Spiel wie das Leben Brens und seines Aishid. Als wäre es nicht schon schwierig genug, die Interessen von Tabini und Ilisidi zu vertreten, beruft sich Machigi auf eine alte Tradition, die Brens Mission noch komplizierter machen dürfte... Wer mit der Foreigner-Serie vertraut ist, weiß schon, auf was er sich gefasst machen kann und darf: vielfältige politische Verwicklungen und Intrigen, eine bis zum Uebersten angespannte Situation, die zwischen diplomatischen Haarspaltereien und plötzlich ausbrechender Gewalt hin- und herwechselt, brilliant gezeichnete Hauptcharaktere und eine bis ins kleinste Detail realistische und glaubwürdige fremde Kultur, in der die Hauptfigur Bren manövriert.
