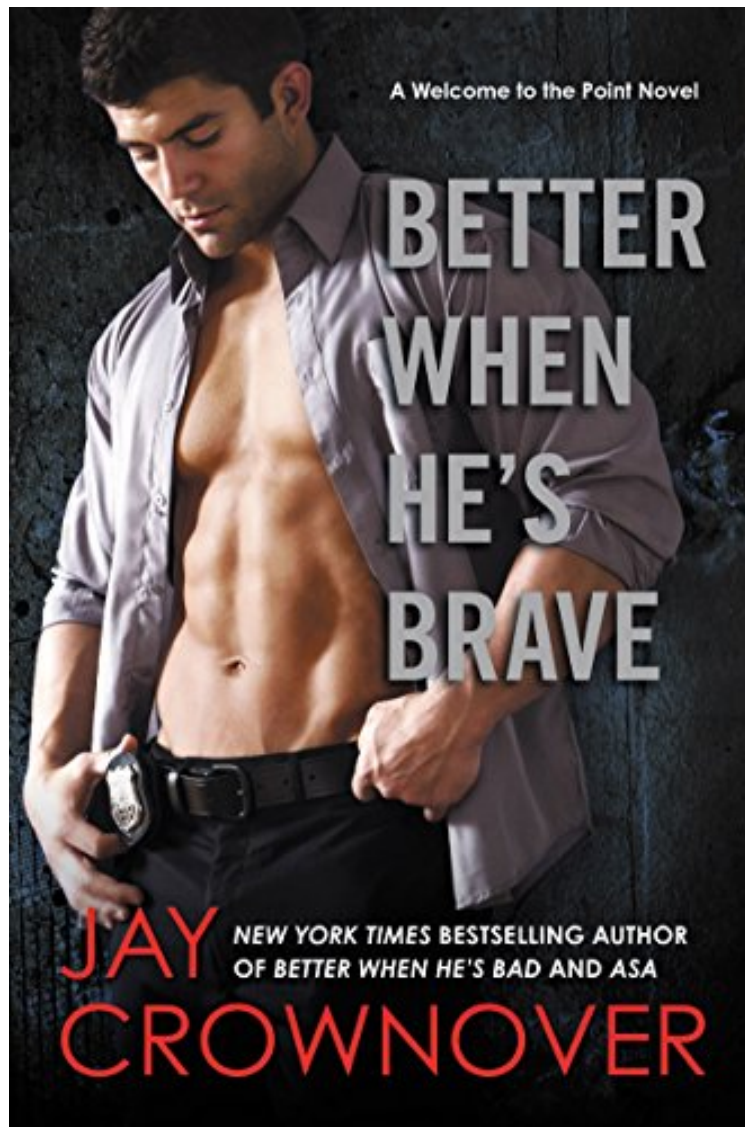

She puts his values, beliefs and convictions to the test and brings out a side in him that he's been trying to keep buried and under control for years. But no matter how much he tries to stay away, he needs her if he wants a chance at ending the war that is raging in his streets. With the two of them working together, pent-up feelings are bound to rise to the surface and force them to question what they believe in. The Point is not a place for happy endings though and as the body count rises and loved ones get hurt, their own interests might count for nothing when they have to look at the greater good. This story was intense, brutal and captivating. There's just no way to ever get enough of Titus. He's just so perfect. For one, he's a cop so he knows how to work those handcuffs. Also, he's a good guy and proof they don't always finish last. He has integrity, values and a sense of loyalty that is off the charts. God, does that make him sexy. But he's also rough, edgy and has an uncontrolled, animalistic side that could bring every woman to her knees. Despite his own convictions, he's willing to let people prove themselves, willing to give second chances. He doesn't give away his heart or trust easily, but when he does, it's for good. I loved the mix of his tough attitude and his love and devotion to others. He's what dreams are made of. That's a belief Reeve and I have in common. Reeve has made bad choices in the past.
