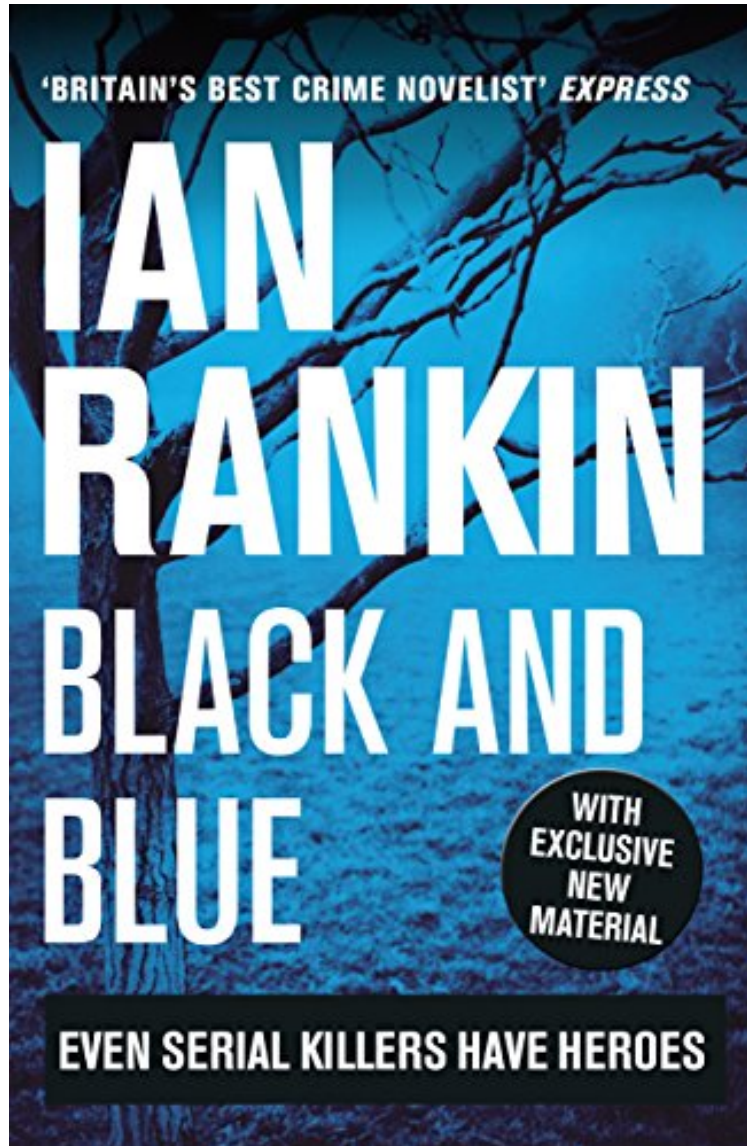

Rankin mixes both his fictional account of "Johnny Bible" and his theories on Bible John ( a real life serial killer who is still at large) seamlessly in this tale involving drug dealing, murder and gangsters in Scotland's three major cities. This is a typical Rebus novel with more twists and red herrings than you can count and yet it maintains feasibility unlike many other novels I could mention.
