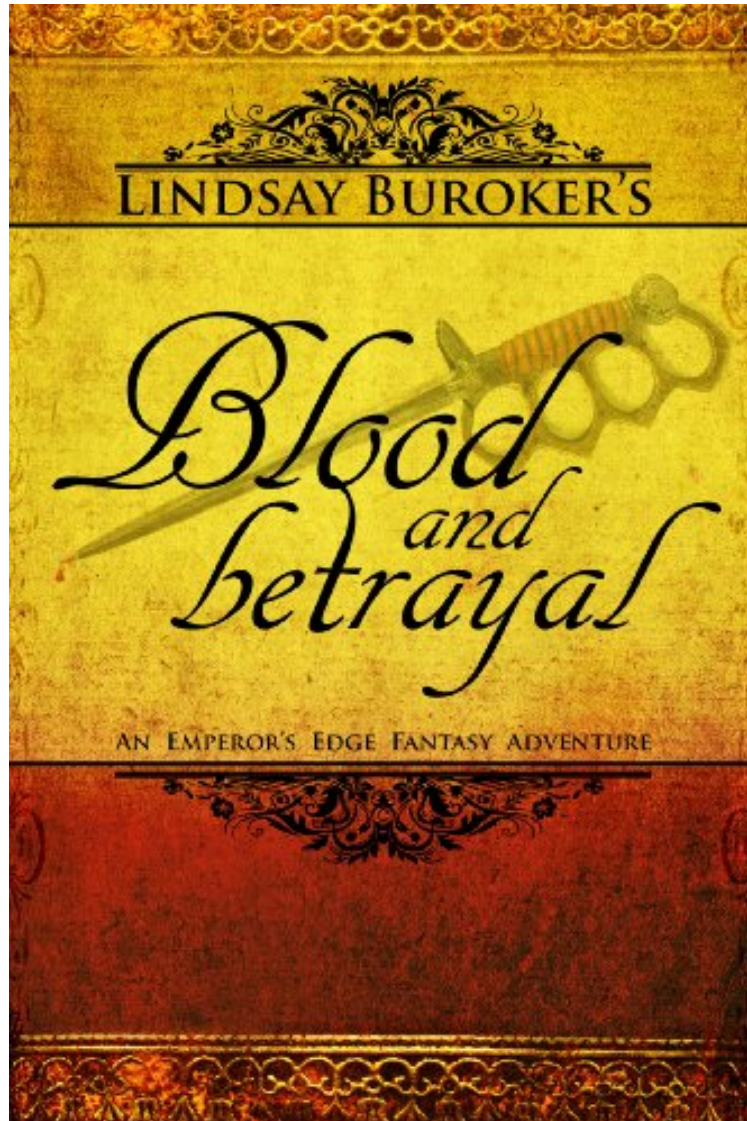

Review If you haven't read the other four books in the series, you should stop right now, buy "The Emperor's Edge" [as it is Book One in the series] and skip reading this review, because I try not to be spoilerish about the events in "Blood and Betrayal", but since the five books contribute to one storyline, there will be spoilers for the first books. Again our heroine Amaranthe shares the telling of the story with one of the other characters - and since this time it's Maldynado, the parts he recounts are kind of lighter in tone, than those told by the other guys in the previous books. Which is totally necessary, because the last book, "Conspiracy", ended with a cliffhanger [how I hate those!]: Amaranthe in the hands of not only her arch-enemies of the "Forge Coalition", a criminal association Amaranthe and her "Emperor's Edge"-Group fight on behalf of the emperor, but also in the hands of "Master Interrogator Pike". "Interrogator" equals "Torturer" and it was hard to read through all that happens to Amaranthe during her captivity. But I liked that Ms. Buroker could convey the feeling of terror and how miserable Amaranthe feels, without telling details. What I liked even more was the conclusion of the "captivity"-part. Sicarius sets out to get Amaranthe back and let's just say... satisfactory end of that story line. I guess it is hard to have someone like Sicarius develop in character without making it unbelievable [as in "The nefarious killer takes a look at the heroine, falls totally in love and is changed forever"... who believes that?], but Ms. Buroker does it. Sicarius shows immense character development by changing slightly in his way to do things or talk to Amaranthe [or the others]. You just know that he will never be a "good guy", he simply doesn't have it in him after his upbringing, but the things he does for Amaranthe show that he really goes out of his way for her. As I'm afraid I wrote quite often in the reviews of the "Emperor's Edge"-Books, the characters are just wonderfully written. Besides the great world building [that just gets better and better - it's not just "Fantasy in a world of steam" - it kind of includes sci-fi as well. And in a cool way!] and the story development as such [yeah, including the relationship between Amaranthe and Sicarius], I love the characters - and I love all of them [which is quite rare, most of the time I have favorites]. Oh and with Mal being the second POV, I just cracked up laughing from time to time, he is hilarious even in the darkest moments ["Spelunking in your cave..." you will know what I mean when you've read it].
