This is book three and it shows well that the series has move beyond its vaguely romance beginnings. It is good to see returning characters from the earlier books, it is slowly getting a bit crowded for the short lengths though. Although the characters certainly are well portrayed for me the plot and the action is the thing. This is a lighter series than the Emperor's Edge in a lot of ways. Sardelle's quest to clear her name doesn't feel as desperate as Amaranthe's and Ridge is far less closed off than Sicarius. Not the least because we get POV chapters from him. The world in the Dragon Blood series is a bit more richly described as well. All of this makes it feel more like a pulp story of the 30s with shining heroes that overcome obstacle after obstacle. I did enjoy the book and am heartily looking forward to the next in the series. Blood Charged ends on a bit of a cliffhanger. Not that any character is left in danger, but there are some open questions in the story that lead onto the next adventure. I don't really understand the title "Blood Charged" either, but that doesn't affect my enjoyment. This is a fun romp of air battles and secret enemy installation invasions. Great old-school fantasy steampunk adventure Von Mina Note: this is the 3rd book in the "Dragon Blood" series and although it might be read as a standalone or one could start the series here, I don't recommend it. In addition, I'll have to assume knowledge of the series in this review. Synopsis While Sardelle struggles to lead an inconspicuous life with Ridge in magic hating Iskandia, the king and the military intelligence gain information of the Cofah empire having gotten its hands on dragon blood and using it to create invincible weapons. So Ridge and some of his flyers of the Wolf Squadron are ordered to fly some Iskandian agents over there to Cofahre to verify the rumors, retrieve blood samples and destroy the labs if possible. To identify all that could be dangerous to or useful for Iskandia in any of the found labs, Ridge is to take Tolemek "Deathmaker" with him, who switched sides in the last book. Sensing he might need all magical help that he can get on this assignment, Ridge finds a way to take Sardelle [and Jaxi of course] as well. Although that probably means the end of his military career. But then one cannot be too careful when heading right into the middle of enemy territory... Review This book totally reminded me of "Star Wars" in a "disable the Deathstar" kind of way: not because of any sci-fi [there isn't], but with the getting into enemy empire territory, be in constant danger of being discovered and doing some break and enter into a forbidding and dangerous place with "Indiana Jones"-like traps and the group getting split up and fighting their respective ways free and so on. I hope you get my meaning. The smooth story-buliding at the beginning aside, this book is pure action, adventure and an unlikely group of people learning to become a team. With all the banter and wise-cracking one would expect of such a group. This time there also is no romance to speak of, but then the two couples already found each other in the previous books. And so this resembled the "Emperor's Edge" books in being action driven, delivering great dialogue and at this point, the world building plays an enormous role and I feel like I know the empire and Iskandia by now, so I can orient myself there pretty nicely. That enhances the story's steampunk/high-fantasy appeal. Considering the end that is no cliffhanger, but only a brief respite before the next adventure, I guess we'll see even more places in this pretty cool world with this group of people I've come to care for. So when the next book is out, I'll sure be accompanying Ridge, Sardelle, Tolemek, Ahn and the others on their next quest.
