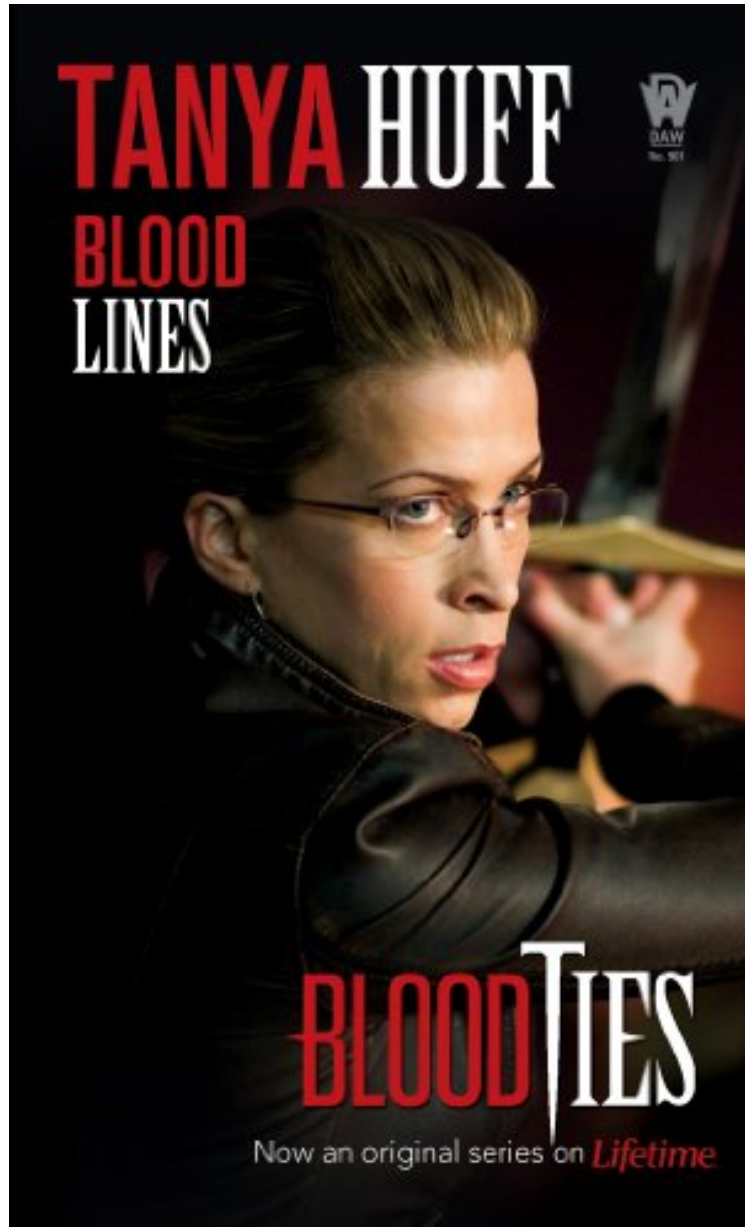

I found that I really liked the three main characters and am interested in how they started out together and how it all ends. Since finishing Blood Lines I have placed an order for the other four books in the series - so that tells me I considered it good. The real telling point for me was when I finished Blood Lines and couldn't bring myself to put it in the "used bookstore" bag. If you are going to read the series, please start with the first book and read them in order. Where that is not really necessary, it does give you some of the history behind the Henry, Vickie and Celluci and they do make some references to past experiences. The return of the Mummy Von hwm Vicki and Henry's third adventure is closer to the Horror genre than all the other Blood-Books. It's less funny, but darker. In part this is due to the antagonist, who is really powerful this time and is more of a personality, and in part to Henry, who has good reasons to be scared. All friends of Tony, the streetwise youth, will be pleased, 'cause he has more scenes than in the previous books (btw. Tony has his own series as well: SMOKE AND SHADOWS, SMOKE AND MIRRORS, SMOKE AND ASHES). Entombed in his sarcophagus and unable to die, the High priest of a dark Egyptian deity has been waiting millennia for his release. Now he stalks the streets of Toronto, seeking to rebuild his god's temple and to shape the world to his liking. Henry fears he is losing his marbles. He dreams of the sun which is tantamount to suicidal thoughts for a vampire. Vicki tries to help him through this difficult time, but has her own difficulties with their growing relationship. Therefore she is almost relieved, when Mike Celluci, her ex-partner at the police force and sometimes lover, asks her to help him with two mysterious murder cases in Toronto's museum for Egyptology. 1 von 1 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich. vampires, detectives and mummies oh my Von Ein Kunde This book starts where the last of the Vicki Nelson books leave off. Henry, the vampire and the bastard son of Henry VIII is having dreams about the sun. He enlists Vicki's help to find the reason behind these nightmares. What they find is a life stealing mummy intent on taking over the city. While this book does not quite measure up to the previous two novels it does a good job a bringing the main characters to the next level of familiarity with the reader. This is an enjoyable series that proves that Ms. Huff is one of the better authors in this genre. A must read for any fan of horror or detective novels.
