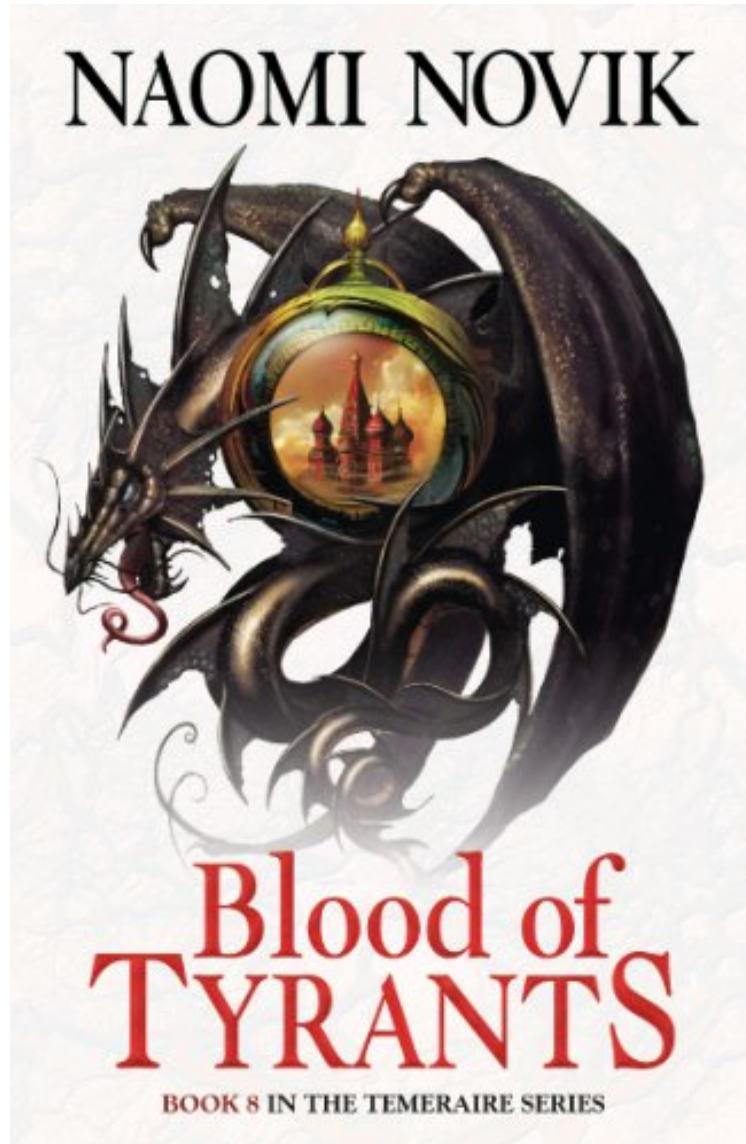

Doch die daraus resultierende Amnesie des Charakters bringt Eigenschaften an ihm wieder hervor, die ich zum Teil ein wenig vor lauter Bemühen, sich nach dem begangenen Hochverrat zu rehabilitieren, vermisst hatte.
