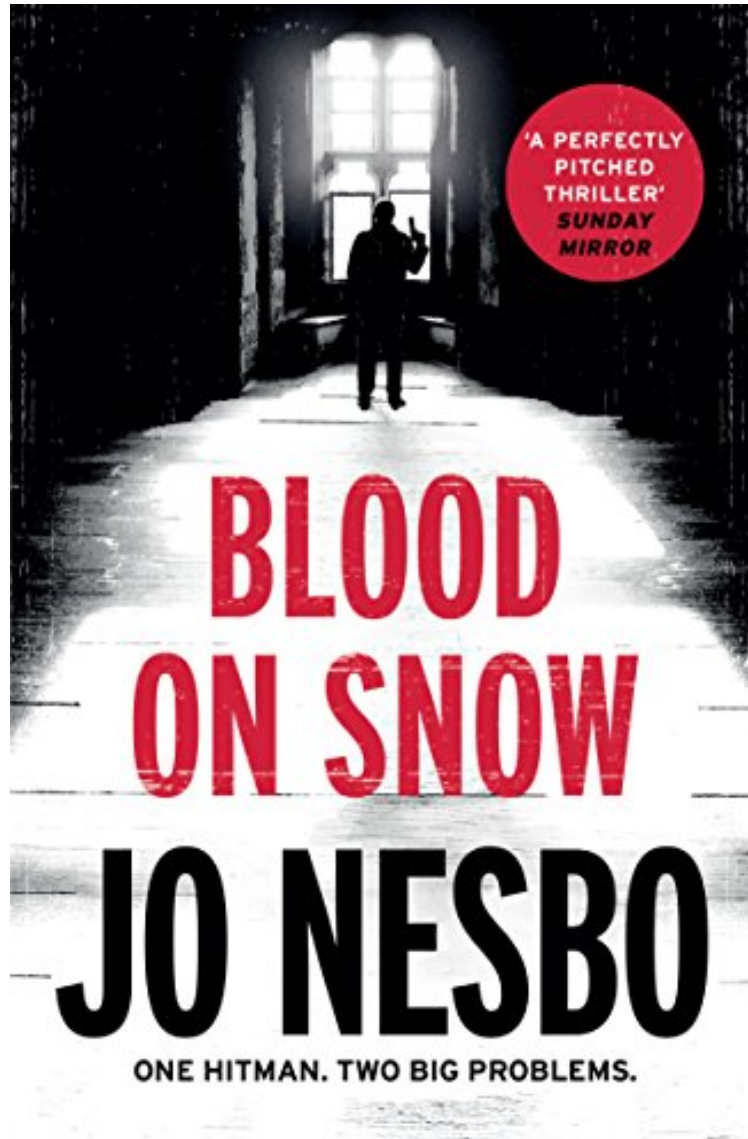

Von Miki101.Micha ... his Harry-Hole thrillers. That is my personal humble opinion. For what it is worth... Blood on snow - and there is really a lot of it, in the Norwegian capital Oslo in December around Christmas of the year 1977. Olav Johanson is a fixer - not of the heroin-using kind. When his boss has someone to be "fixed", there comes Olav. Who is a young man with a lot of problems. He is no good with beating prostitutes to work, he cannot do any good with maths, driving a escape car after a robbery has brought him and his colleagues a stay in prison. He is also dyslexic, which is not a bad thing per se - this way Olav is reading books more than once and understands a lot more than people would think. He had a very very disturbed youth because of a father in and out of prison cells, and when out, he beat up his mother and abused even worse of her. One day Olav discovers to be the son of his father. And that was that for the troubled family. Olav is a kind soul with a tender heart. But everybody has to work and Olav "fixes" for Daniel, and the victims are mostly employed by the Fisherman, Daniels adversary in crimes and trades. Then comes the day Daniel wants got get Corina done - his unfaithful wife. OK, so Olav starts reluctantly watching her for her daily routine and ... something happens to our silent and obedient young man... And there the things start to go downhill. Olav, who had a silent and distant admiration for Maria, a deaf, dumb (?) and mute girl of very simple appearance, changes abruptly his "object of desire" . And he makes a decision which will slash out against a lot of people and will change his life and that of a lot of others not properly in the planned direction... Being a fan of Jo Nesboe for about 15 years now, I like his Harry-Hole thrillers most. Some more, some less. This is an totally new, old world. Chinese who make pizza, telephone booths, old-fashioned dresses, weapons and ways of treating enemies. Olav is a very well developed character with all his flaws, which he knows better than the other people. He may seem a simpleton, but he has hidden depths. And I went along with him, and I was able to understand how he ticks and acts - until the very end. But the other protagonists are merely sketches. There should have been a bit more of information. And there is an other flaw in the "fairy tale" about Olav, Corina, Maria, Daniel, the Fisherman and friends and all the others - the end. It was a bit too hasty and metaphoric for my taste. But that is my personal opinion. The book is very well written, in some kind of simple speech as Olav would have used it. It ist fast-paced and has a lot of surprises in it. But it is short, way too short - I reads it in 2 hours. Therefore only 4,4 stars. I simply like my "Nesboes" longer. But it is really a worthy read for the fans of Jo and scandinavic thrillers. But this one thrills in a more calm, cool and collected way. My fifth star maybe comes along with the translation into German, because the English language per se is very concise and laconic. We will see...
