Many unexpected turns Von Mina Note: this is the 4th installment of the Blood Destiny UF series and although there aren't crass cliffhangers, the books each contribute to an overall story arc. So this is not a good place to start the series and to that effect, I recommend to start with Bloodfire. Review Oh my, this book's ending effectively broke my heart and in a totally unexpected way. Actually there are a lot of turns in the plot I didn't anticipate in any way and that is a good thing, since reading that many UF/fantasy/PNR books means that many more times than I like, I'm able to tell what is going to happen next. Here: not so much. As in prior books, the plot starts right after the end of book three: Mack is settling in her new home in London and she and the recently awakened Mrs. Alcoon are only a few days from re-opening the bookstore. Mack's problem, however, are the otherworld's factions power struggles that revolve around her. Fae, mages and shifters are worried for her safety now that the dragon is out of the bag and each of these parties is also afraid, she could fraternize with one of other groups and they'd not be included. This leads to hilarious scenes with mages, shifters and fae tumbling over each other on their respective guarding duty. I especially did crack up every time, Mack the grumpy dragon opened the apartment door roaring and some poor guy scuttles away, afraid, she actually bit some head off. All that guarding of course doesn't prevent Mack from getting herself in various degrees of deep trouble: there is the vampire-problem still unresolved. Mack hasn't forgotten that it was Aubrey the master vampire who started the trouble that got her friends killed. So she wants revenge. Then she needs new knives and the only payment to the troll who sells them she can provide, is doing him a favor. And as if that weren't enough, she is asked by the dryads for help as well. So Mack is pretty busy... and nearly nothing turns out as planned. Instead, she gets the most unlikely sidekick ever [he is so annoying and at the same time hilarious, I was laughing out a lot] and an enemy who turns out to be more than she can handle on her own. I can't say any more about the plot without spoiling things big time, but the fight at hand is not really solved at the end of Blood Politics. It's not a cliffhanger, more like Part 1 of a larger theme was set. But the book's title is more than fitting, since in the end it's politics breaking heart. Sadly, I really can't tell more. But it made my eyes water. Mack is mostly the more mature person she has become over the course of the last books, but there is one decision she makes in the state of emotional turmoil that is so unbelievably stupid, i.e. dangerous, I had the urge to shake her. Hard. But as I said, overall she is a decent person and I love her inner monologues and her snarky comments on each and everything. The book again is a pretty good addition to this very entertaining UF series and if I have a complaint, it's the seemingly lack of proper editing, since the mistakes [words missing, wrong words, words printed double...] haven't decreased in any way since book one. The really good story deserves just more than that. But nevertheless: I'll start reading book five Bloodlust right now a bit anxious by the way, because it's the last book available and I don't know, if the series will go on and if so, how long I'll have to wait for any possible sequel. 0 von 0 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich. Doch bevor es zum Ende kommt, habe ich erst noch die Rezension zu Bd. 4 für euch. Wie bereits in den vorangegangenen Bänden ist auch hier der Schreibstil beraus angenehm leicht und flüssig zu lesen. Sie schafft es mich von Seite 1 an bis zum Schluss an die Geschichte zu fesseln, so dass ich das Buch gar nicht aus der Hand legen will. Bei der Handlung wird sie konstant interessant und teilweise spannend fortgeführt. Es werden zahlreiche neue Fragen aufgeworfen zu denen man unbedingt die Antworten hören bzw lesen möchte. Mit interessanten Wendungen, Erkenntnissen und der ein oder anderen Überraschung hält die Autorin ihre Leser bei der Stange. Was mir nicht sonderlich gut gefallen hat war die doch sehr plötzliche romantische Entwicklung zwischen Mack und Corrigan. In den anderen Teilen sind sie noch umeinander herum getanzt und hier dann ZACK! Doch das ist auch der einzige negative Aspekt an der ganzen Sache. Nun da ich Bd. 4 gelesen habe bin ich wirklich gespannt, wie Helen Harper dies zu Ende führen will ... Alles in Allem toll zu lesen und ich freue mich auf das Finale! Mein Fazit: 4 Sterne - wer Gestaltwandler, Feen oder Magier mag kommt hier auf seine Kosten, doch Vorsicht! es ist auf englisch!
