There is heartbreak, epic fights including the showdown, incredible sacrifice and a so satisfying end that wraps up everything just fine. The author did so well letting everything come full circle.As sad as I am that the series is finished, I appreciate it that the story arc was well developed and brought to an end at the right time. You know, no dragging stuff along and stringing the reader with it, but a clean plot with a believable end that had its surprises and its heart wrenching moments and I cried over people I would never have thought I'd do that.Mack really has grown up, she is admirable in her resolve and there are moments, I was shouting out loud at how great it was, what she was doing. She has become the heroine the others hoped her to evolve into and even more: she got into her role as a leader, not loving it, but doing what is necessary.Of course, the rest of the character cast is there, too. And I liked it that they did not disappoint as well.I'm just realizing that I'm gushing, yet I can't say much about the plot without spoiling all the fun. I can tell that her job will bring her as far as Russia, that she has to deal with lots of publicity as her secret being a dragon was spilled, that she has a night at an UnSeelie bar that ends rather surprisingly, that Endor the villain sadly is a worthy, aka hard to fight against, enemy and that she finally gets to know a lot more about her family.You'd best just read it yourself. If you liked the series so far, you'll love the finale. And although the editing-problems with the missing/wrong/doubly used words are still there, I was so breathless with the plot, I hardly noticed them after a few pages. Oh and there are parts of the story re-written from Corrigan's POV as novellas, the first being Corrigan Fire.
