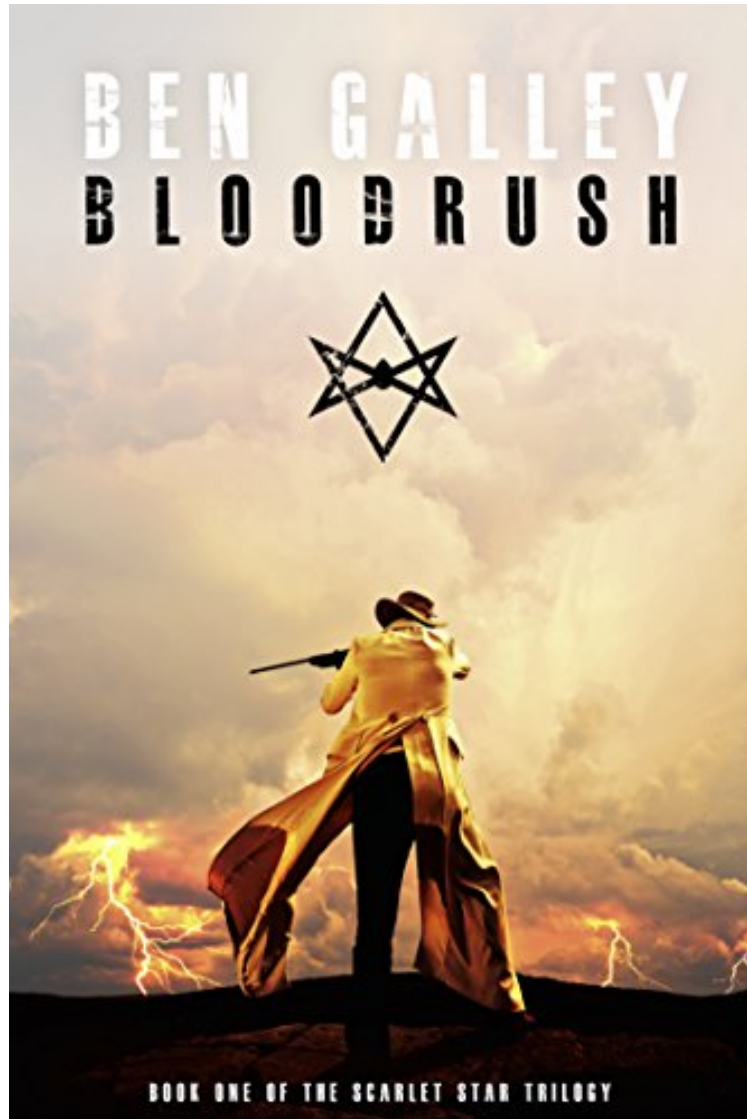

Anders als bei seiner "Written" Reihe spielt Bloodrush nicht mehr in einem klassischen Fantasysetting sondern bersiedelt in einem Parrallelwelt in dem das Britische Empire noch immer seine Finger ber den ganzen Globus verteilt hat. Der Protagonist der Serie wird doch eine Reihe von Ereignissen die sich bereits im ersten Kapitel erffnen nach Amerika verfrachtet. Pltzlich findet sich unser Protagnist nicht mehr im vikorianischen London wieder sonder in einem der vordersten Orte im neu erschlossenen Amerika. Hier beginnt dann auch die eigentliche Handlung des Romans und im Laufe der nchsten Kapitel lernt man die hier ansssigen Einheimischen wie auch die mythischen Wessenheiten kennen. Vorallem aber das von Galley erdachte Magiesystem gibt dem Buch seinen eigentlichen Charme. A decent fantasy-western Von Andy W Couch I chat with the author on Twitter occasionally and got excited when he talked about writing a "weird western" story. This is that story. Bloodrush is a pretty good read, but more toned down than I was expecting for a weird-west story. I was expecting an over-the-top action fest and it is actually deeper than that, in a good way. The main character is a thirteen year old boy and while there are definitely the western stock characters, they swirl around him instead of being the center of the story. Stylistically I couldn't get into Galley's other series "The Written", calling it too wordy. His basic style of intense description exists in Bloodrush but is tempered by the faster nature of the story and I actually quite enjoyed it. I had a little problem with his fairy character which doesn't seem to have the "standard" fae problem with iron, but it didn't distract from the story. Overall a good book and a decent read. I had expected for more action scenes and they are there, just much later in the book than I had hoped. The tagline mentions it is part of a trilogy, so I will be interested to see it go further.
