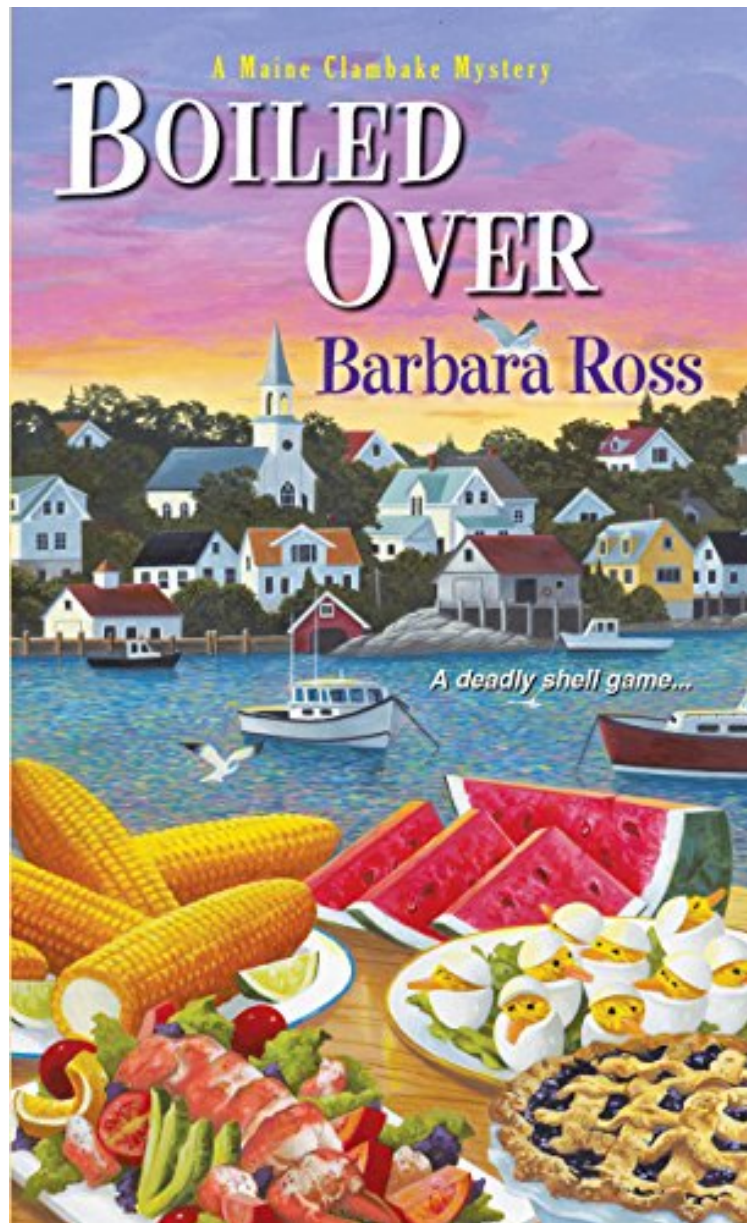

The mystery story line is well-developed, lots of red herrings, and I snapped up the bait several times. So either I'm dumb or this is a good one. And again, Julia has a good motive to go after a murderer as opposed to pure curiosity or self-importance, and she tries to cover her back, she's not totally death-driven. The only thing I couldn't fathom was that somebody would drive such distances spontaneously on a notion of maybe finding a titbit of information. But that may be just my German constant traffic jam background. I guess readers from the bay area might feel the same. I said this in my review of #1 - this book isn't life changing, so I won't give it 5 stars (for comparison, Louise Penny's "Still Life" got a 5\*). But I have read the first 4 in a row, which must mean something! And I have to admit that I have asked Barbara when #5 will have an audio book added to it.
