The heroine is too stupid to possibly live, and the hero is just plain dumb. I threw this book--THREW it--when, after being kidnapped at gunpoint by the hero, the heroine escapes at a gas station and starts to run away, but she goes back to his car for the towels she had just

purchased at a department store. And it only gets worse. The heroine gets a ride home from Billy Bob (oh, and you can just imagine what HIS character is like) finds her house trashed and shot to hell, but instead of having Billy Bob take her to the police, she hangs around and mixes drinks. Of course, that's when the kidnapping hero shows up again--but instead of closing the door on him, or getting Billy Bob to help her kick him out, she offers him a drink as well. THEN, the shotgun toting "Hispanics" show up, the hero pulls out his gun to defend the occupants of the house--the heroine is so angry when she realizes that he kidnapped her with a gun empty of bullets she jumps him, he rolls on top of her, and all she can think about is the sensuality of his body. All this while a gang of Hispanic men are shooting shotgun rounds into her living room! A deputy arrives to do a little investigating at her house, but does she inform him that the man she is with kidnapped her earlier that day? No. Why? Because he saved her when those hooligans were shooting shotguns into her room. Oh, and did I mention the pig masked man? Well, the fact that he held a gun to the heroine's head doesn't matter either, because her scream brought the hero's half-naked body into her room for her to lust over. I'll be honest. I couldn't finish this book. I tried. I thought it might get better. I thought the heroine might smarten up, the hero get more interesting. It didn't happen, so I gave up. My only concern is that if these had been real people, as stupid as they are and as much as they lust after each other, they could populate the world with too-stupid-to-live children in a short amount of time. I did not feel stupid when I couldn't predict the heroine's actions; instead, I felt that she was not as intelligent as she is supposed to be. I am a fan of spunky, unpredictable heroines--try *Midnight Kisses* by Kimberly Raye, *High Energy* by Dara Joy, almost any book by Jillian Hunter, Julie Garwood or Jill Barnett. They have heroines who are fun (and funny) without compromising their intelligence. In this book, the heroine is working on her doctoral dissertation; however, being told she is smart doesn't do it for me. Ms. Riley should SHOW that she is smart, and frankly, her actions (and reactions) are as dumb as they get. Yes, this book is funny and sexy, two things that I appreciate in books that I read for pleasure.
