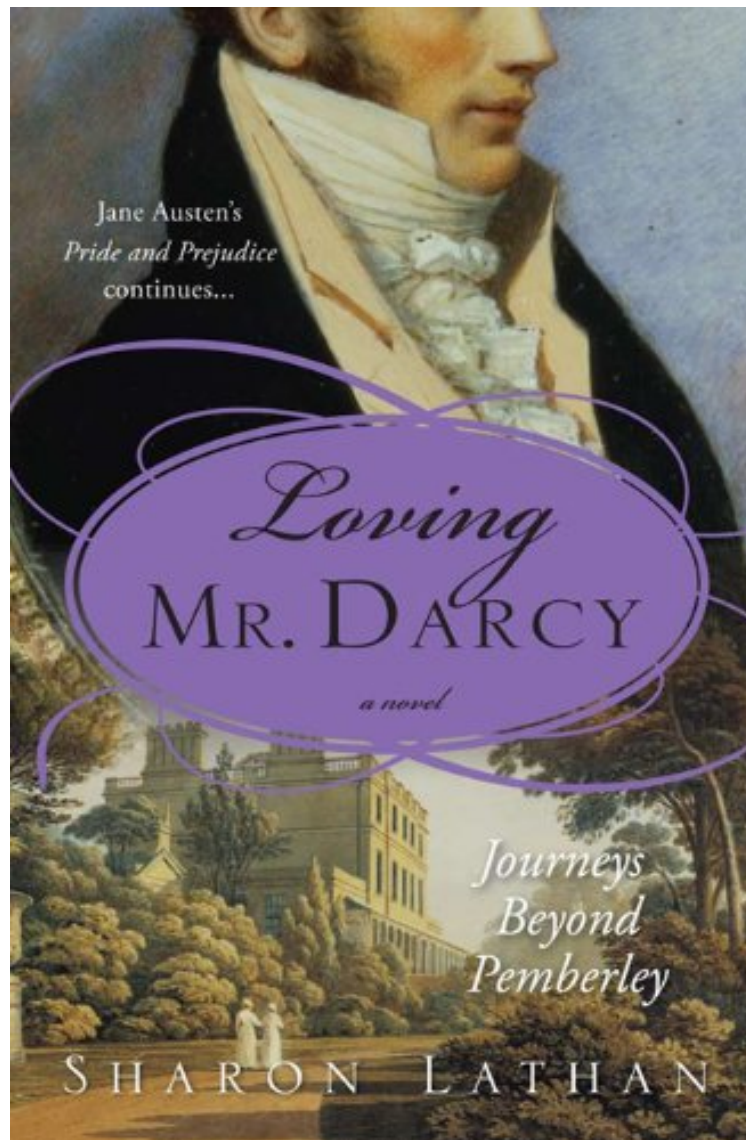

Sharon Lathan reintroduces a lot of well-known characters and tells what becomes of them once PP is over, but she also comes up with a lot of new characters. There is not too much actual activity in this novel apart from Darcy's and Elizabeth's bedroom activity which the author seems to enjoy most of all. If you thought 'Mr. and Mrs. Darcy - Two shall become one' (first book) was horrible, corny, cheesy and ridiculous, then keep your paws off this one. Because it doesn't get any better. This book is not really well-written. The author varies tenses and points of view and something like historical research obviously didn't come into her mind before writing this book. However, this book is really good fun! I enjoyed reading it, but this is for people only who can put up with historical inaccurateness, the Darcys (and especially Mr. Darcy) swearing his eternal love for his wife on about every second page and not too much of a thrill. Sharon Lathan does not represent Jane Austen's characters the way they are, of course, but is this really to be expected? Jane Austen was probably the best author ever concerning her characters in accurateness and detail. This book is recommendable, as long as the reader is ready for this and doesn't take everything in here seriously. For me, it was a page-turner, even though it also annoyed me every now and then. Finally, I don't think Jane Austen would turn over in her grave.
