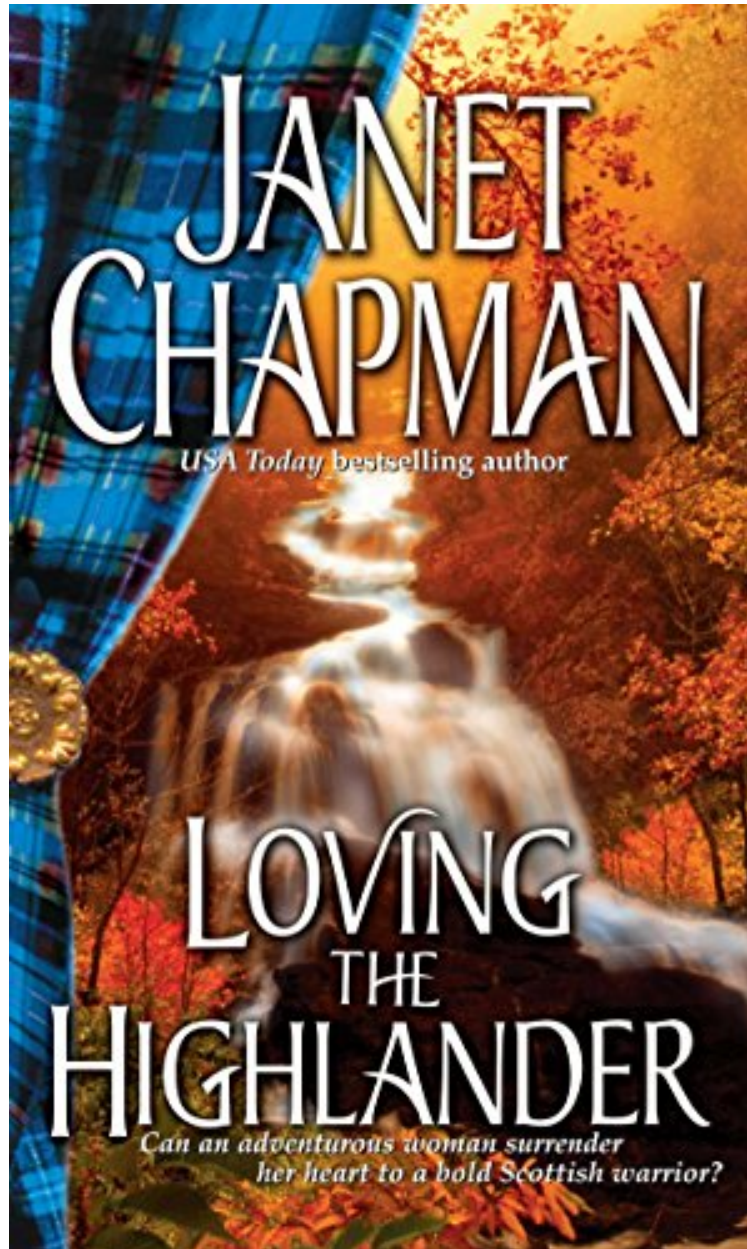

But she needs a man to fight her fights, a man to tell her what to do, and a man to come to peace with herself. If I wanted a Hemingway story, I should have gotten one.
