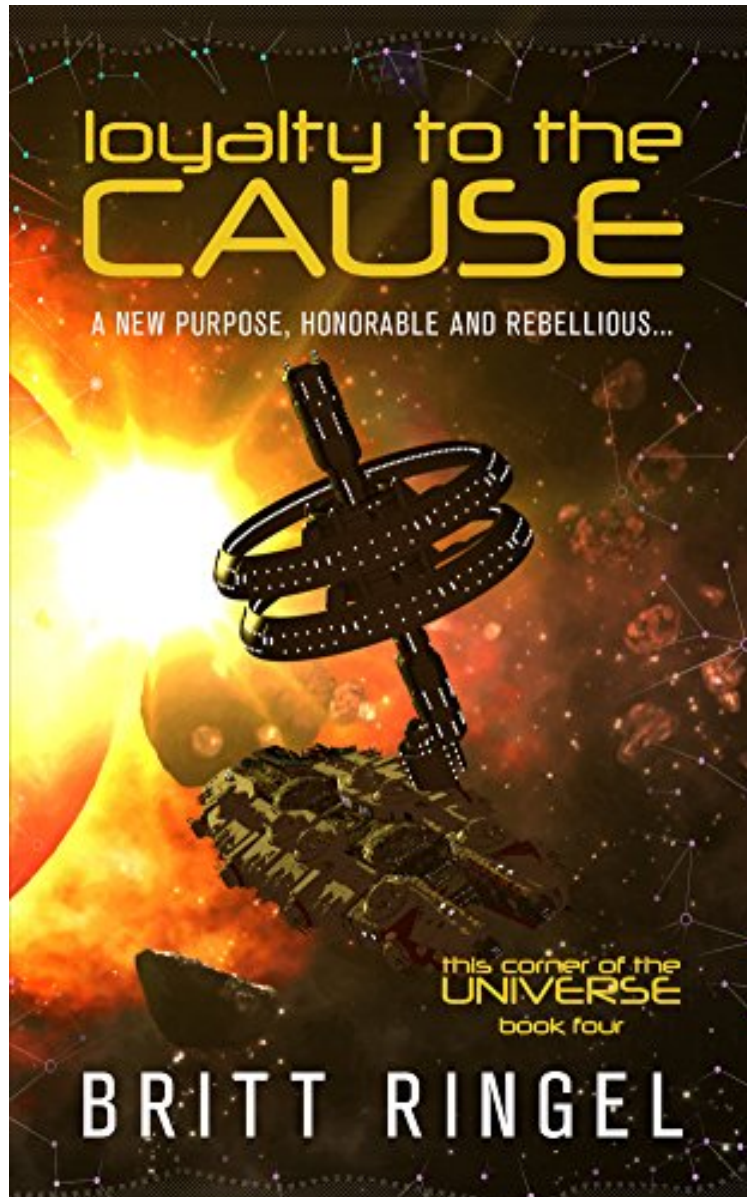

TintenkriegerLoyalty to the Cause is the fourth book in the TCOTU Series by Britt Ringel.It describes the flight of several members of the Brevic Republic and some of their friends through republican space with several obstacles to be overcome.While the story itself is, again, thrilling and Britt Ringel manages to create a good deal of suspension with a couple of nice unforeseeable turn-arounds, it still has too many flaws to make myself give it more than three stars.Some of my points I already have addressed directly to the author, but I'll gladly repeat them here:Even in the fourth book, Ms.Ringel doesn't stop with the wrong physics. That has been a nuisance going on over the whole story arc, where she repeatedly disregards the difference between velocity and acceleration. At least in book#4 the reader isn't pestered as much with the constant distance countings, although this is mainly due to the fact that the first half of the book doesn't really play in the vastness of space.On to the next, she introduces a new character, Joachim Müller. That engineer is allowed to speak a couple of sentences in German. Or, let's say, something resembling German if you travel back in time 80 years, mix in a sitcom like Hogan's Heroes (Ein Kfig voller Helden), pour in a healthy dose of bigotry and mix all of it with Google translator. Please show me the German intercontinental(interstellar) consortium that would name its ship "The Slut" ("Das Flittchen"). Not gonna happen. I wonder if this character stems out of a deep seated hatred of Germans or simple ignorance. Regardless, it's just one character and doesn't harm the story too much.And finally we see, as in so many other sci-fi stories at the moment, the unabashed copy from seafaring stories. Instead of just going with space ships, Ms.Ringel also makes the bad mistake of introducing space as the new wet navy. And this time, she even goes so far and adds sails, smartlines, chartrooms (although no one needs them) and other wet navy related junk to the story. Disappointing and boring, to say the least.And totally incongruent. I am not going into long winded explanations on why unnecessary rooms would not be included in space ship design or why it's pretty unlikely that future day space ships should have worse monitoring and controlling systems than we do nowadays.I was trying hard to enjoy this story and the storyline in itself would have made that easy. Several smaller flaws, the constant referrals to wet navy and the neverending lack of understanding for the physics involved while still constantly and excruciatingly detailing the involved distances made it a drag which I set aside quite often.1 von 1 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich.
