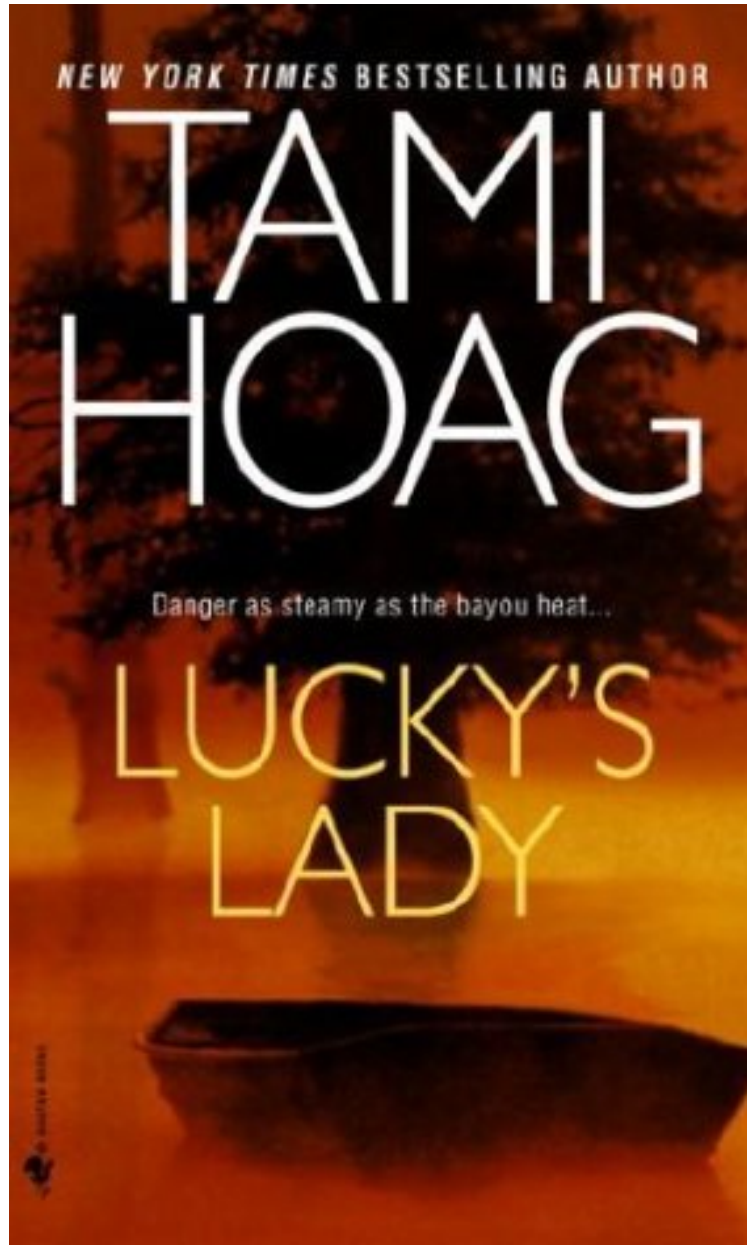

Nestled in the heart of lush Amish farmlands, this small, idyllic Minnesota town would allow her to put a shattering divorce behind her. But as any other small and quiet town the locals do not like strangers were noticeably cool to the newcomer--who was rumored to be a gold-digger--especially when she started stirring up controversy with her newspaper. And now when a murdered body appears at her feet, she was a suspect..particularly with the arrogant sheriff whom she dislikes at first and falls in love with later An ex-pro athlete who had returned to Still Creek a hero, Sheriff Dane Jantzen doesn't have much use for the media--especially not in the form of this glamorous, gutsy outsider who spells trouble with every word she prints. So when she becomes his suspect in a vicious crime, the last thing Dane expects is the jolt of attraction at their every encounter. Elizabeth would soon challenge Dane's every assumption, including the one that he's better off without love.

Heavy on the romance, light on the suspense Von Ein Kunde A slightly better than average offering from the very capable Tami Hoag, who thrives on mixing edgy romance with suspense and crime. For those who have read other books by Hoag, "Still Waters" does not measure up to her best work - "Night Sins" and "Guilty As Sin." In this book, Hoag drifts off track from the suspense plot frequently, while over-dramatizing the sex and romance storyline. Hoag also gets lazy with her editing/vocabulary - the same words and phrases turn up on every other page. The word "sardonic" appears at least thirty times, and everyone in the book seems to "arch a brow." Hoag also fails to present a heroine/protagonist of her usual caliber; the lead character is hyper stereotyped as the rough-edged, tart-tongued Texan with her Gucci bag and "Caddy" automobile. The book is quick paced and interesting enough for a good read on a slow afternoon, but definitely not Hoag's best work to date.

When Serena Sheridan leaves her psychotherapy practice in Charleston and returns home for a vacation, she finds that her twin sister is planning to sell the family estate to an oil company as a way of financing her husband's political career and that her grandfather has retreated into the swamp in protest. Serena hires Lucky Doucet--a devastatingly handsome Cajun (she thinks of him as "a devil on steroids")--to help her find the old man. Though at first put off by his macho manner, Serena succumbs quickly to Lucky's prowess in the bedroom. But great sex does not a relationship make; Lucky's troubled and bitter past keep him from offering Serena anything more than his magnificent body. Meanwhile, Serena becomes more deeply embroiled in her own sea of troubles, which include dealing with her willful grandfather, an unscrupulous representative from the oil company, and the seething resentment of her sister. The plot culminates in an attempt on Serena's life--engineered by her brother-in-law--from which Lucky rescues her in the nick.
