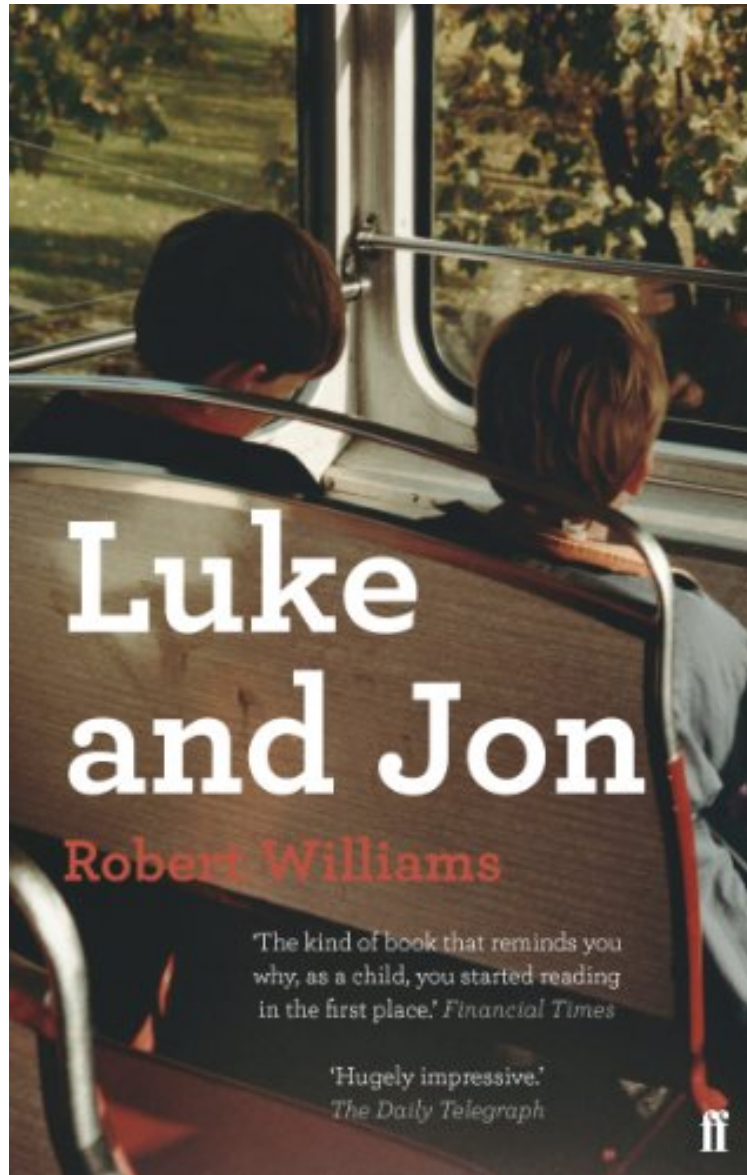

Luke nimmt sich seiner an, wird dadurch mit seiner Trauer fertig. Er hat eine Aufgabe, jemanden, um den er sich kümmern muss, wo er doch gerade selbst alles verloren hat. Diese Geschichte geht sehr sensibel mit dem Thema Trauer um, zeigt, dass Eltern/Erwachsene nicht immer stark sind, Kinder manchmal stärker sind oder sein müssen, weil ihnen gar nichts anderes übrig bleibt. Hinzu kommt die Behandlung des Themas Freundschaft, die hier so dargestellt wird, wie sie wirklich sein sollte: Einsteher für den Freund, auch wenn das nicht nur Vorteile für einen bringt, auch wenn er einen manchmal nervt. His father starts drinking, can't pay the bills anymore. They lose their house and have to leave town in England to find another, cheaper place. Their new house in a completely new place is awful. Everything is broken and a mess. Soon, Luke meets a weird boy named Jon. He has old clothes, behaves oddly. He lives with his grandparents and gets bullied at school. Jon starts showing up at their new house and talking to Luke and his father. Soon Jon becomes not only a very close friend but also a part of their family and Luke realizes what is important for him in life and what friendship really means. This novel, published in 2010 by Faber and Faber, is a heart-moving story about a boy who has to deal with his mother's death and a totally new life situation. Main character Luke is characterized as a very mature and smart teenager. He likes drawing and is a thinker. He does not care too much about what other people think about him. The most important part of the book is not the actual action but the thoughts of Luke. He asks himself a lot of questions about life, love, family and relationships. The way author Robert Williams expresses everything really puts the reader into Luke's situation. His extraordinary explanations show that this book is written out of experiences. He makes the reader think. What do people actually mean to you, what importance do they have in your and others lives? His friend Jon is also in a hard situation. Only having his grandparents left in family, he is poor, alone and misunderstood in school. The reader finds out about different ways to deal with problems and gets to see the world from a desperate situation. Yet these thinking parts of the book are combined with an interesting and partly suspense action. It is not a very complicated book and seems very easy to read, however its message is very interesting and important and only understandable if read slowly. This is not the kind of book you take with you to the beach to just have a nice, easy read. It is a sad story but at the same time also hopeful and the mood gets happier.
