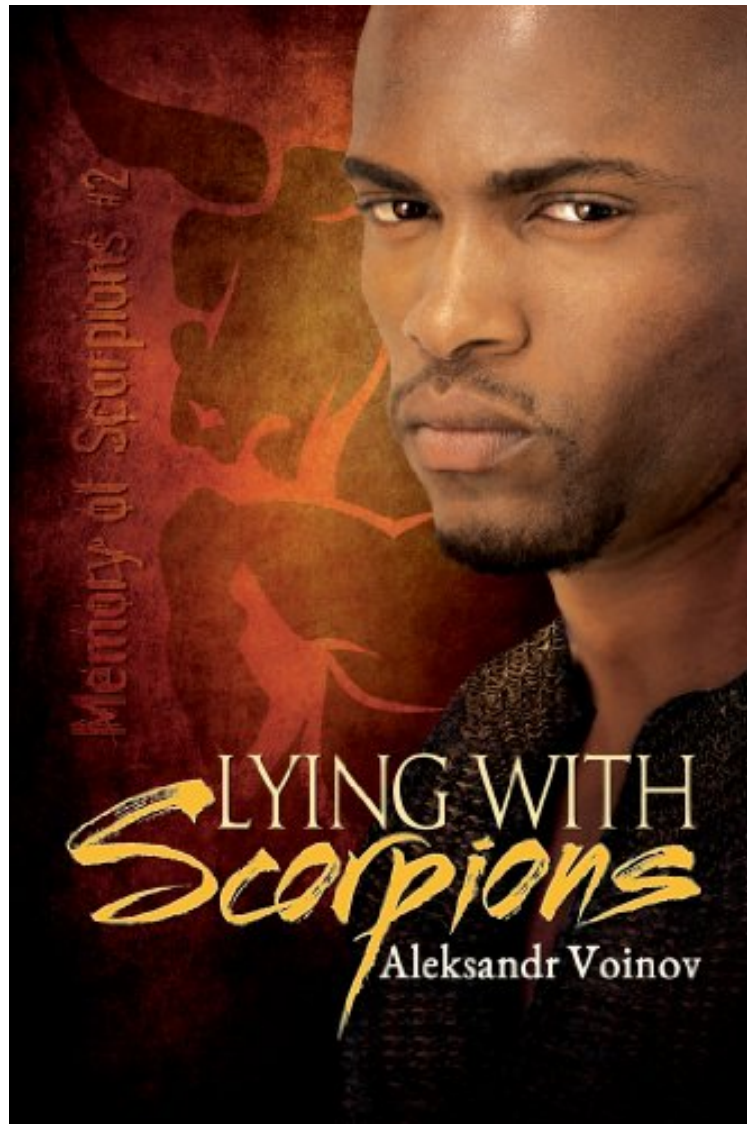

about the progress of the story in Voinov's next book telling the story of Kendras and his Scorpions. I think I liked this book even a bit better than the first one as I've connected with the characters very deeply by now and I was happy reading about them again. A great part of the plot focuses on Adrastes. After he has become Lord Protector of Fetin, he now approaches Dalmar because his ultimate goal is the reunion of the different lands of the former empire Shara. Meanwhile, Kendras works on rebuilding the Scorpions, an elite group of soldiers, that is only loyal to him, the officer. In *Lying With Scorpions*, Kendras learns a lot about himself, his past and heritage, his friends and companions, and most importantly about Adrastes. The former officer has changed a lot and Kendras is about to discover that for himself. Adrastes has to behave like the nobleman he truly is and it turns out that he's very ambitious in the field of empirical politics. How much space is there for his lover in this new life? I loved Adrastes in the first book but now Voinov shows his other sides, such as cruelty and calculation. What will Kendras do now, where should his loyalties lie? I've developed a soft spot for Kendras. In the first book, it was hard for me to connect with him. He's not a man of any words and certainly not a fan of sweet-talking. But then, it's his actions that count. He's so very loyal to his men, the Scorpions, and I love his compassion and his strength. Voinov has developed highly complex characters, and a big cast of them. In this sequel, there are new Scorpions made and the old ones kept growing on me. I was sad that there wasn't much more to learn about Widow. I hope that will be the case in the next book. He seems to have a special connection the raven assassins and I'm curious to hear how he ended up with the Lady Protector. But the author made it up to me by introducing Graukar. He becomes very important for Kendras. I enjoyed their easy conversation away from all the court intrigues. I can't wait to read more about all those wonderful people. I want to hear more about Lady Nhala, Lord/Lady Amrash, Dev and Riktan, Runner, Graukar and Shadow, Adrastes and of course Kendras. Die Scorpions erholen sich langsam von den Verlusten vergangener Schlachten, finden neue Rekruten, doch das Leben in Dalman hlt seine ganz eigenen Herausforderungen bereit, gilt es doch Adrastes Thron zu schtzen. Was diesen zweiten Teil in meinen Augen so besonders macht, ist die schleichende Vernderung in der Beziehung der beiden Figuren Kendras und Adrastes, eine Vernderung, die man nach den Geschehnissen und Bekenntnissen des ersten Teils so nicht erwartet htte, die man dem Autor aber hundertprozentig abnimmt.
