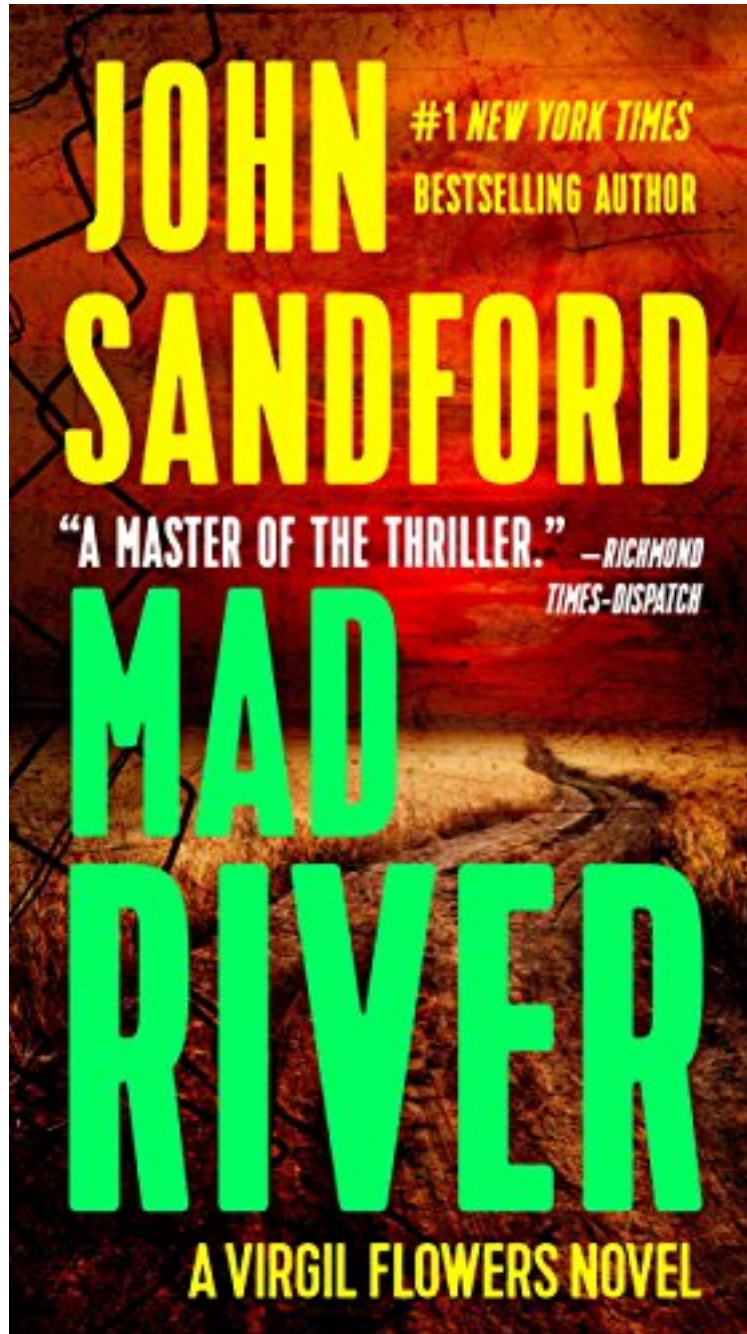

The dynamics are quite good up until the very end where Sandford must have decided that he needed another 70 pages and messed everything up quite a bit. The ethics become a little bit too "real life" for my taste, he never explains why some important things, lets Virgil make a strange decision to get it all started and so on ... really that ending needs a makeover. Otherwise ... language and characters are good as always with Sandford ... all the small stuff like dialogue, landscape, etc. fits ... As lately in many of his books he had to put in some nasty sex and bathroom stuff which I don't care for - compare with the early Prey books where such content was handled in a much more acceptable way. I have no problem to read something like that where it fits and in the right degree of detail but lately Sandford seems to try to become "creative" in that area ... in at least 4 places in at least 2 books some guy has to experience an (non-sexual) emotion "right down into his balls" ... seriously :-( ???
