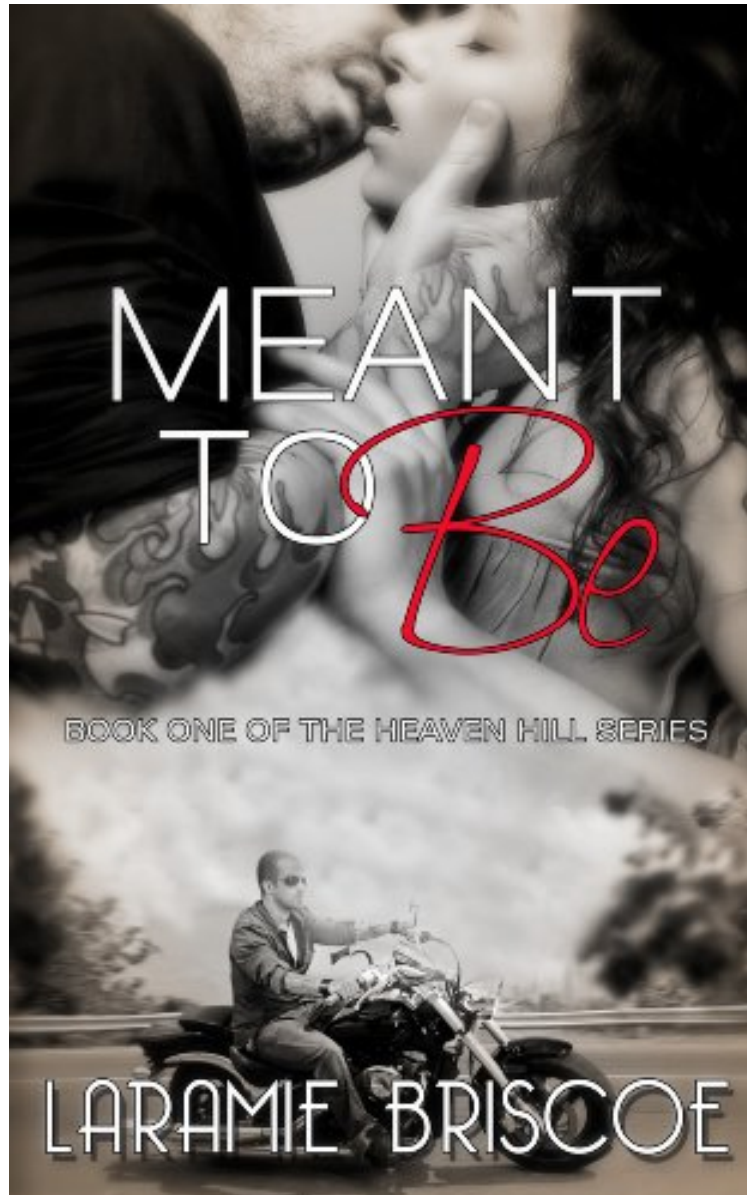

Undeniable series by Madeline Sheehan, I have been in love with this world. Unfortunately, there aren't many books that are up to standard when it comes to editing and storytelling. Believe me, I've read A LOT of biker romances lately and most of them have been disappointing. Thankfully, *Meant To Be* wasn't one of them! *Meant To Be* tells the story of VP and hard core biker Liam Walker Jr., the son and heir apparent to the president of the Heaven Hill Motorcycle Club. When his sister inadvertently involves a coworker in the biker world, the club decides they want to use Denise to aid the club. Since Denise is in a bad place in her life and can hardly put food on the table, she agrees. Her life will change forever. *Meant To Be* does show the tough sides of the biker world. Yes, there is violence and there is a dark side. That's what I expect from a contemporary romance featuring a motorcycle club and that's what I love. I was very pleased that, while this dark side is shown and not played down, there is no cheating or unnecessary violence in the book. If a scene is violent, it is part of the plot and needed to support the story line. Also, the language is quite clean for this type of read. There is cussing, but it is not overdone to make a point. The language as well as every action the characters take, feel natural. Liam is a very interesting and complex character. He was born into this hard and violent world in which the club and brotherhood come before anything else. He is torn between his love for the club, his family and Denise. From the very beginning I had the feeling that Liam would bring change to the Heaven Hill MC. His father, the current president, has no scruples and Liam struggles with that. He has trouble with combining the rage inside him with the gentle and kind man he is with Denise and her kids. The most beautiful aspect of this story is the relationship between Denise and Liam. Laramie Briscoe captures the excitement of a new relationship and the first date, but also perfectly shows the beauty of trust and having a partner who understands you better than yourself and accepts your flaws. This author is strongest in the romantic relationships. There is magic between Liam and Denise and it was my favorite part of the book. My only point of critique with this book, and the entire series in fact, is the editing. There are some small grammar and spelling errors but they weren't distracting in any way. I immediately dove into book 2 of the series, *Out Of Darkness*, which tells the story of Liam's best friend and MC brother, Tyler Blackfoot. Tyler and Meredith's story starts in *Meant To Be* and it is essential to read this book first. I am very excited about this series and want to spend more time with the Heaven Hill MC. The club brothers are all men I want to know more about and whose stories I'd love to read. I highly recommend this book to lovers of biker romances who are looking for a great series to feed their obsession!
