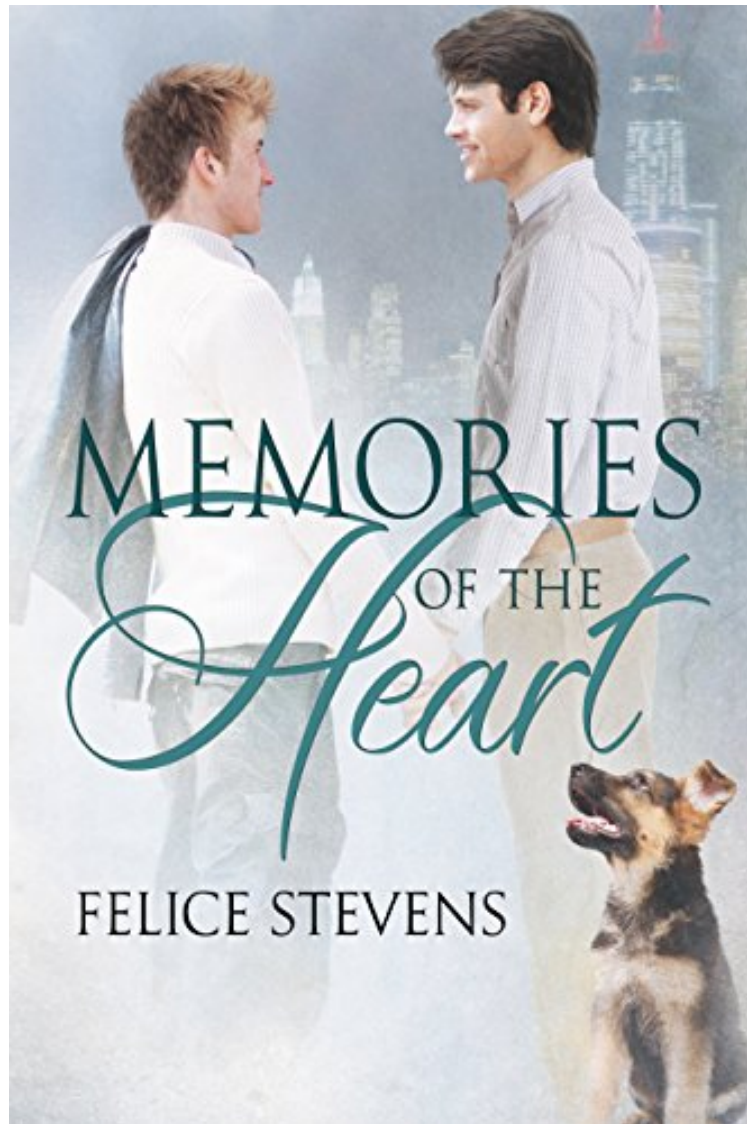

descriptions the reader just gets to know the characters really good. Well, I didn't like Micah - like at all. He was mean, self-centred, arrogant ... Josh on the other hand was sweet and nice - and seemed like a total pushover. Maybe that is the reason for him falling in love with the wrong guys, his ex definitely is an ass, too. So, Micah is fitting. Alex - a friend of Micah, though Micah is too egoistic to be a good friend in return - is a nice guy and well-presented. Micah, being the arrogant elitist man he is, looks down on Josh (who is "only" a barista). Josh is compassionate, intelligent (well, not in his love life) and has a big heart. In short: they just don't match. So the "change" in Micah wasn't believable at all. A meddling grandma (later two meddling grandmas planning a marriage) starts the story. And while the plea of the grandma only provokes Micah's anger, he suddenly falls in love with Josh, happens to be the perfect grandson, partner, friend, colleague ... It just wasn't believable at all. In addition, I prefer stories where the MCs are able to solve their problems without help (or with minimal help) from meddling others. It would have been so much more convincing for Micah to change after his grandma got ill. As it is, he couldn't convince me of his changed character and I pitied poor Josh the whole time. He would have been so much better without Micah. And the meddling grandmas were kind of sweet but too much for my liking. The permanent misunderstandings of the MC's should have clued them in that they just are not made for each other. If they aren't able to get a HEA without other's help - just drop it. Obviously, they (more like Micah) is not willing to invest anything in a relationship. Again, poor Josh - but he shouldn't have chosen Micah in the first place. However, three points for a good writing style and in-depth characters - even if I didn't like Josh's bitchy colleague (ex sister-in-law), Josh's idiocy in falling for another Mr. Wrong, Micah or the constant meddling. But the grandmas were sweet, Alex was a really good guy and a wonderful friend. And not liking the characters doesn't mean I couldn't appreciate them.
