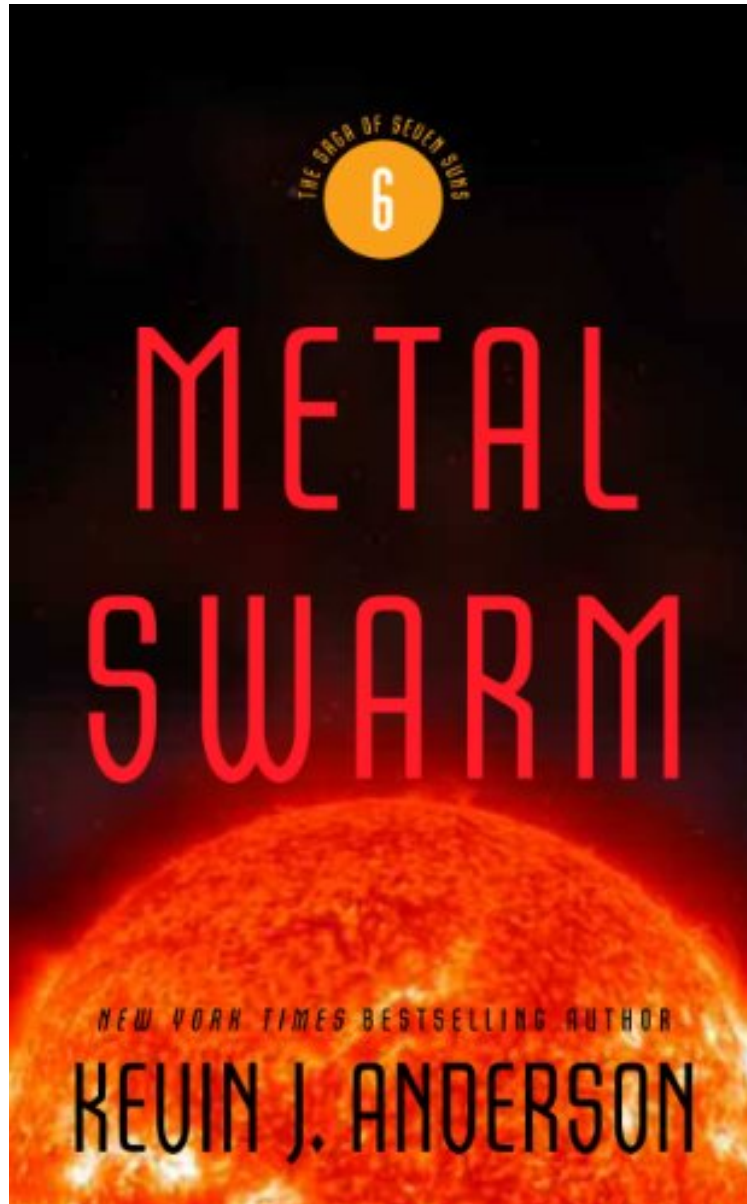

Doch auch die Elementawesen lassen wieder von sich hhren. Nachdem die Hydrogues nun endlich vernichtet wurden kommt der totgeglaubte Rusa'h mit einer Armee von Faeros und versucht ziemlich erfolgreich eine ildiranische Welt nach dem anderen abzufackeln, ohne das Jora'h etwas davon weis bzw. dagegen tun kann. Gleichzeitig greift Chairmann Wenceslas zu immer drastischeren Mitteln um die Apsaltung zahlreicher Hansakolonien zu verhindern, die sich Peter's neuer Fderation anschliesen wollen. Doch anstatt die Welten im griff der Hansa zu halten schafft er es durch ein Blutiges Massaker auf Ursk auch noch die letzten treuen Anhnger vom ihm abzuwenden... Alles in allem ist es ein gwohnt gutes Buch aus dem Seven-Sunns-Universum, doch fragt man sich langsam wie Anderson all die vielen verbliebenen Gegner in nur einem einzigen verblebenem Buch vernichten wills, insbesondere im Licht dessen, wie lange er fr die Hydrogues gebraucht hat.
