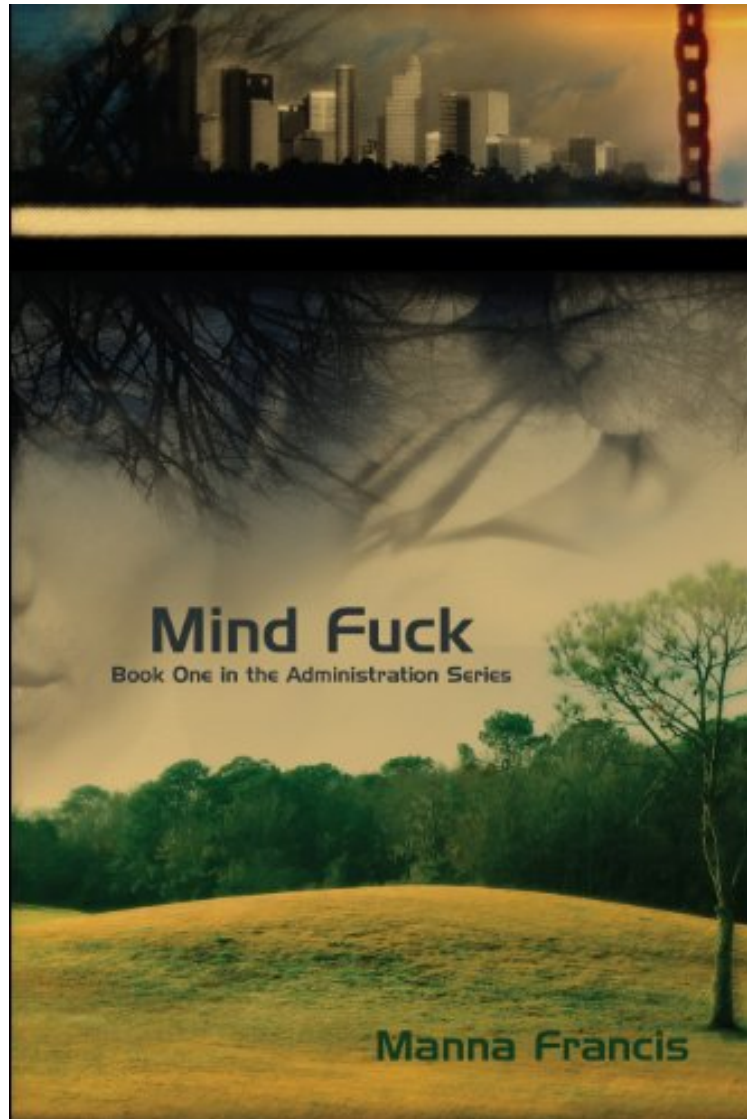

Ich bin beeindruckt von dem Buch, weil es eine Reihe der blichen Klischees umgeht - der eine "Held" ist eitel, skrupellos, oberflächlich, sex-besessen, charmant - warum interessiert er mich? Weil man am Ende meint, da er das Potential zur Vernderung hat -

weil es sein könnte, da er eines Tages lernt, da er lieben kann. Sein Gegenüber - Warrick - ist stark, eigensinnig - das Gegenteil einer 'damsell in distress', und von Beginn an liebenswerter trotz seiner Kühle. Unsentimental, brutal (der Administration als bewachungsstaat kommen wir immer näher), spannend. Ich fand den Krimi-Teil überzeugend genug, bin aber keine eingefleischte Kennerin der Materie. Technisch ist das Buch SF, tatsächlich beschränken sich die Zukunftsvisionen auf ein automatisiertes Transportsystem, die Weiterentwicklung des Gehirn-Computer-Interfaces und insgesamt auf Erfindungen, die vorstellbar noch in diesem Jahrhundert erreicht werden könnten. Ich hoffe sehr, dass genügend Menschen dieses Buch kaufen, denn ich weiß (früher konnte es man noch im Netz lesen), wie die Serie weitergeht - und die besten Geschichten kommen noch! This book was truly amazing in every single detail, in every single aspect. I really have nothing to criticize. Nothing--Nada. The characters are intriguing, astonishing, manipulative, sexy. Toreth is, by all means, not a good person. He is a cruel, socio- and psychopath. That alone should tell you that he doesn't normally give a f*ck about anyone but himself [let Sara, his admin, be the exception of the rule]. He plays games with other people, likes to torture them, not just within the framework of his job in the Investigation and Interrogation Division. It rather is a mystery that he hates the Psychoprogramming--"Mind F*ck"--Division with such a passion, since he himself has so much fun f*cking with the minds of others. Did I mention that I love reading about him? I admit I am somewhat of a sucker for psychopaths with the tendency to develop (eventually) something like a heart. [Yeah, chances of that happening in the real world are rather nonexistent, but in my fiction I love it nonetheless... ;)] Warrick seems to have at least his moral values/standards in order and is therefore more likable. He is intelligent and--as Toreth puts it--resourceful. He isn't hesitant to protect what's important to him, even if that entails breaking the law. He also knows how to play games and often manages to beat Toreth at his own game. I loved that. The interaction between those two fascinating personalities is enthralling, to say the least. There is a gripping murder investigation. Add politics, kinky sex, power games--both physically and mentally, corporate sabotage, blackmail and even a conspiracy of some sort to the mix, and you get this perfect thriller.
