MinaNote: this is book two in the Cainsville mystery series and the books rely heavily on each other, plot-wise. So I don't recommend to start here, but with Omens. ReviewAs with the first book, I was so captivated by Olivia's world that I couldn't really snap out of it and am even now thinking about it all. One could say that this series really sucked me right in and I still love every second of it. Sadly, I can't tell you much about the plot without spoiling it big time. I'll do what I can, though. The story sets in just a day after the events in Omens: Olivia is at her former home to get a few clothes and stuff and finds the body of a woman dressed and made look like her. Spooked, she calls Gabriel, but when he arrives, the body is gone. But after the events the two of them went through, he believes her immediately. The missing body [and it reappears at times, just to keep things creepy] is the starting point to an investigation Olivia and Gabriel launch and it becomes more obvious by the day that there is a very supernatural angle to it all. And clues pop up that lead to Cainsville. Speaking of Cainsville, Olivia finally finds out about Cainsville, not all of it, but the most important parts. The big secret so to speak. And her deduction is flawless! Not only that, but how she plays it, is just awesome. She is so in the top three of my most adorable UF kick-a** heroines! But there is a lot happening all at once, not just the search for the body, the woman's killer and the connection to Olivia [which takes the backseat the first half of the book]. There is a lot of character development, mostly with Gabriel, but others as well. But especially Gabriel gets a lot of [appreciated] page-time and this makes him even more well-fleshed out than he was in Omens. He struggles hard to adjust to a life with someone like Olivia in it and he messes up amazingly! If you've read the prequel, you know that there still is the secret about James Morgan, the ex-fianc, paying Gabriel to protect Olivia. Well, this plays out exactly as you'd think it would. And speaking of James, Olivia is considering mending fences and I'm nearly choking on all the things I would love to say about that, but no, the no-spoiling rule still applies and you'll have to read for yourself. Oh and to make the confusion complete, Rick re-appears and impressively so. To sum it up, this is one of the best mysteries with a magical touch I've ever read. The world-building is sound, the characters three-dimensional and the protagonist is a study in wit, depth and quick-wittedness.
