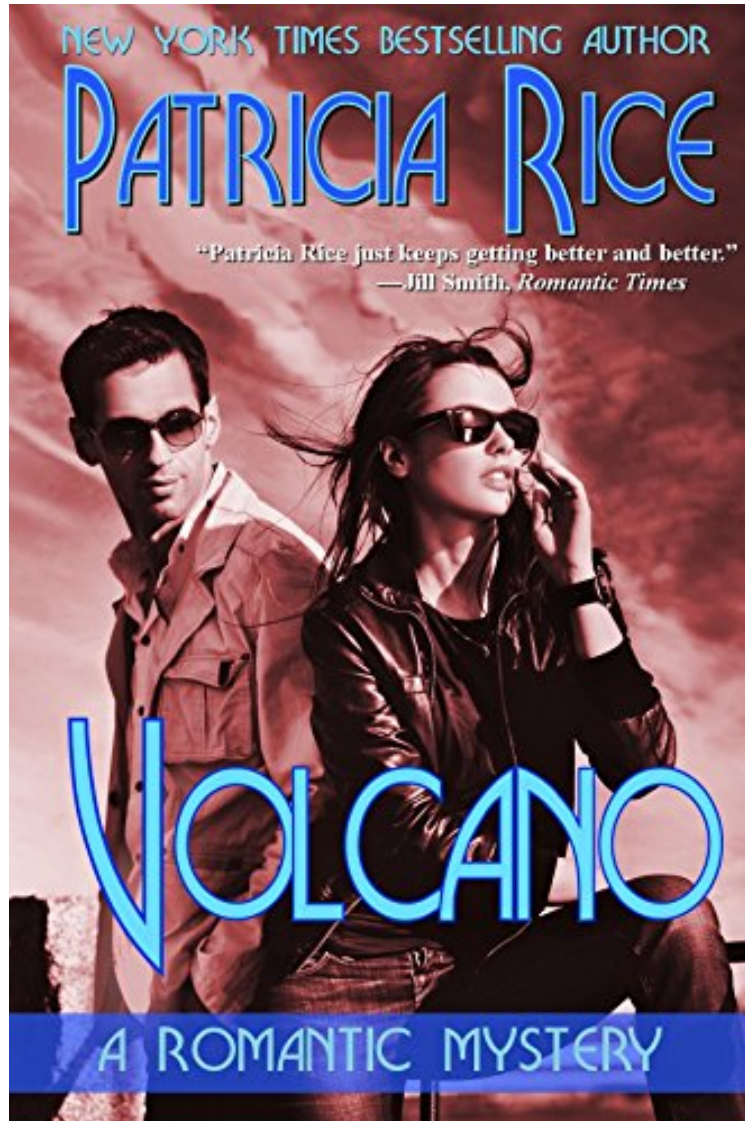

I would've liked more information earlier in the book as to exactly what Charlie was worried about/running from, because it seemed a lot of time was spent initially running about and escaping--and I had no idea from what. Rather than suspenseful, it was confusing. An inkling or two would've cleared this up and made the suspense a bit more focused. I also didn't think the reader had to be told repeatedly that the hero was an ex-football player with an ex-football player physique. After a while, the heroine's constant reference to the oaf/ape/big lug/dumb jock etc. was distracting. In this case, a little goes a long way. All in all, a solid read and a rollicking good adventure story.
