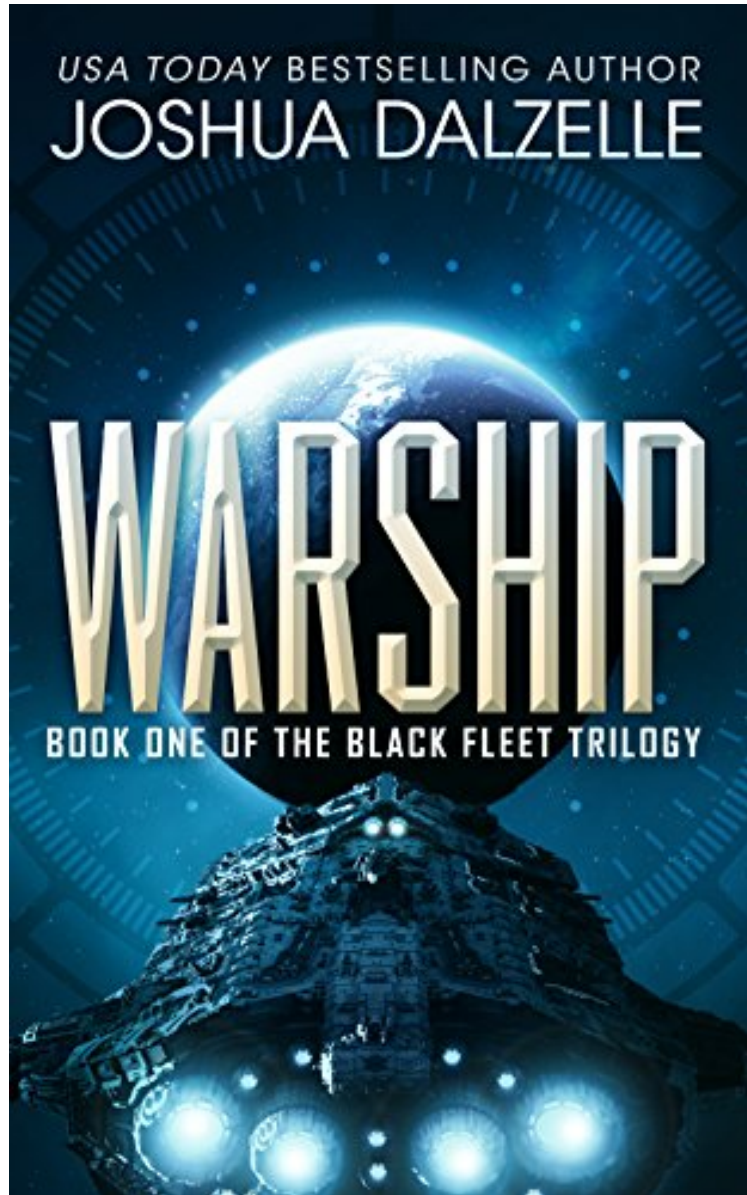

The idea is not bad, a stripped down military (not a new idea though) which is more show force because of long lasting peace, and clerks in the upper echelons running it. Then hostile aliens turn up and the equivalent of Bruce Willis in Die Hard has to fight them off with a figurative handgun. But, first the book is very short. Second, I am not sure I would have bothered reading to the end if it had been longer... Sorry, but a supposed spaceship is no submarine or airplane, when I hear a spaceship giving rudder to starboard I stop taking the book serious. Furthermore the author goes Star Trek - Captain goes with the away party, complete with Redshirt buying it to emphasize the danger. What not even Star Trek would feed the audience is the firefight during which the Skipper kicks the gunner out of his seat and takes over for him, just to realize one cannot command a ship while doing other peoples' jobs, and is then grateful when his XO volunteers to take command for the duration... And did I mention the ship's only Ensign usually standing watch while Lieutenants answer the phone? As I said the idea is good, the beginning is promising, but it goes downhill fast.
