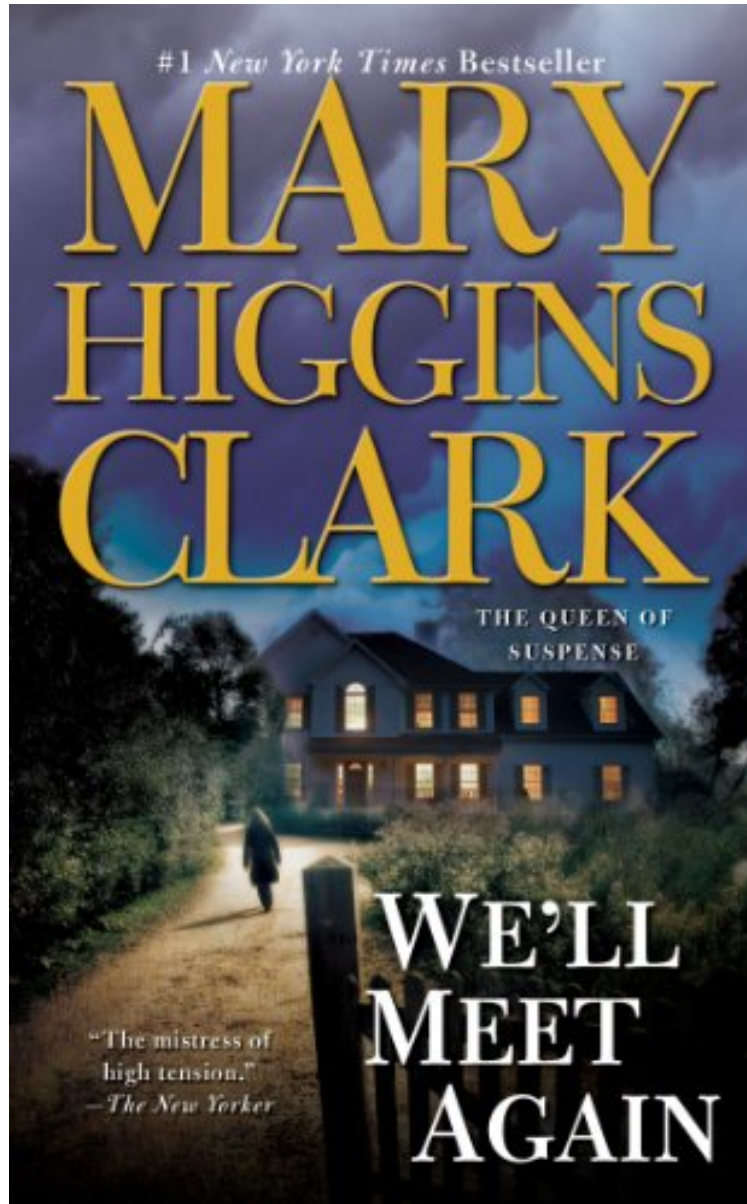

The state of Connecticut accuses Molly Carpenter Lash of murdering her spouse Gary in cold blood. The testimony points out that she angrily left for the Cape a week ago. One particular witness, who loves Molly, sadly states that she found the accused sleeping in her bed while her husband lay dying. Finally, they found his blood on her person. Molly swears she does not remember what happened after she returned home. Fearing a hung jury due to the fact that Gary's girl friend was pregnant, the DA cuts a deal with her attorney to change the charges to manslaughter. Molly accepts and goes to prison for a maximum stay of ten years. Five and a half years later, the state paroles Molly. She informs the media that her memory has begun to return and firmly believes that she did not kill her spouse. She insists a third person was in the house when Gary died. Molly believes that one day her full memory will return and she will know the identity of the true killer. Molly has thrown down the gauntlet, setting in motion a series of murders that lead back to her.

WE'LL MEET AGAIN is an enjoyable who-done-it that will provide immense pleasure for fans of Mary Higgins Clark. Though the overused amnesia gimmick seems too convenient of a mechanism, the mystery remains taut and filled with red herrings to make Molly appear guilty even to readers who know otherwise. Especially interesting is a former classmate of Molly, a reporter for the True Crime TV show, who provides insight into the convicted murderer's personality. Ms. Clark has written an entertaining novel that is fun to read.

For anyone who loves the classic murder mystery story, Mary Higgins Clark's We'll Meet Again will exceed every expectation. The story centers on the socialite Molly Carpenter Lasch, who, five years prior to the beginning of the story, pled guilty to murdering her husband, Dr. Gary Lasch, despite the fact she remembered nothing about the night he was killed. After being released on parole, Molly asserts her innocence again in front of the media. Among the media, Fran Simmons, an old classmate of Molly's from high school, begins covering the story for the local television station for a segment called True Crimes. Molly contacts Fran and convinces Fran to help her investigate the murder further in order to find the answers to that tragic night. During the course of the investigation, tragedy strikes again when the body of a key witness is discovered only hours after Molly questioned the witness. To the surprise of many, the book holds the reader captive until the very end. This is one of Clark's best works so far. For a fast paced and intriguing murder mystery, We'll Meet Again is one of the best new novels available right now and a must read!

The mistress of high tension (The New Yorker) and undisputed Queen of Suspense Mary Higgins Clark brings us another New York Times bestselling novel that she prepares so carefully and executes with such relish (The New York Times Book ) about the murder of a respected doctor and his beautiful young wife charged with the crime.

Dr. Gary Lasch, famous Greenwich, Connecticut doctor and founder of the HMO Remington Health Management, is found dead in his home, his skull crushed by a blow with a heavy bronze sculpture, and his wife, Molly, in bed covered with his blood. It was the Lasches housekeeper, Edna Barry, who made the grisly discovery the morning after Molly's unexpectedly early return from Cape Cod, where she had gone to seclude herself upon learning of her husband's infidelity. As the evidence against Molly grows, her lawyer plea-bargains a manslaughter charge to avoid a murder conviction. Released from prison nearly six years later, Molly reasserts her innocence to reporters, among them an old school friend, Fran Simmons, an investigative reporter and anchor for a true-crime show. Molly convinces Fran to research and produce a program on her husband's death. As hidden aspects of Gary Lasch's life and the affairs of Remington Health Management come to light, is Fran herself the next target for murder?

We'll Meet Again ist voll von den Zutaten, die Mary Higgins Clark-Verehrer verschlingen werden: Temporeiche Spannung, Doppelspiel treibende Bsewichte, romantische Intrigen und ein gewaltiger Showdown. Schwerer zu verdauen ist der bermige Gebrauch von Theatralik. Sie taucht immer dann auf, wenn die Autorin "eine satanische HMO" -- eine aus Freiwilligen bestehende Gesundheitsorganisation -- und ihre Legion von bsen rzten beschreibt. Der finsterste Schurke darunter ist Peter Black, dessen Augen "kalt, zornig und drohend waren -- gewi nicht die Augen eines Heilers." Trotzdem, von der Melodramatik abgesehen, versteht es Mary Higgins Clark nach wie vor, eine gute Geschichte zu erzhlen. Die Heldin ist Fran Simmons, eine Enthllungsjournalistin, die der cleveren, findigen Dr. Susan Chandler in You Belong to Me nicht unhnlich ist. Fran wurde gerade engagiert, um fr die populre Fernsehsendung "True Crime" zu arbeiten. Zufllig hat eine frhere Schlerin ihrer alten High School -- der vornehmen Cranden Academy in Greenwich, Connecticut -- mit ihrem ersten Auftrag zu tun: Molly Lasch wurde eingesperrt, als sie Mitte Zwanzig war, weil sie angeblich ihrem Ehemann mit einer bronzenen Remington-Figur den Kopf eingeschlagen hatte. Nach diesem Mord an dem Gemeindearzt, der noch dazu Generaldirektor eines rtlichen HMO war, war Greenwich wie gelhmt. Fnf Jahre lang behauptete Molly, sie knne sich an nichts erinnern -- aber nun, da sie auf Bewhrung freigelassen wird, kehrt ihre Erinnerung bruchstckhaft zurck.
