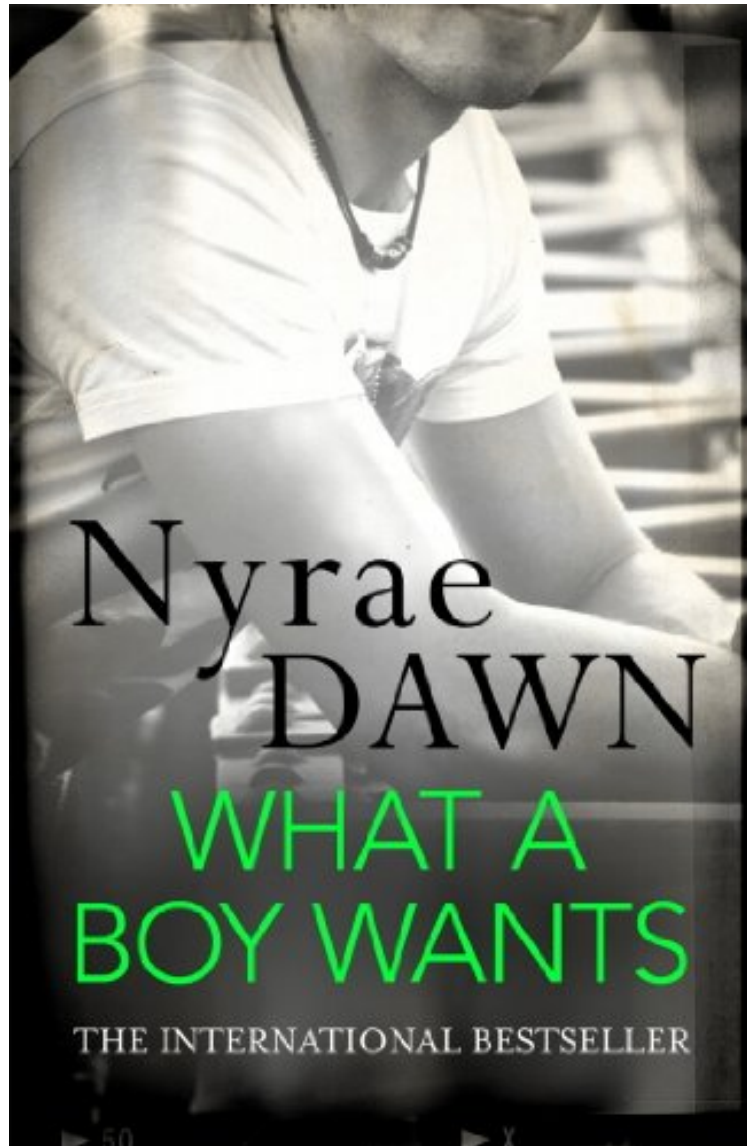

Today I am writing a review about another book written by a female author written once again from a male's POV and I have to admit it was much, much better (worse would have been difficult). Here the story reminded me a little bit of the movie "Hitch" but for young adults. Plot: Sebastian Hawkins lives with his mom, who is not really lucky with man. In order to earn some extra money he has become the Hook-up Doctor (self proclaimed)!, which means that via Mail he advises girls how to get the guy they want, not how to keep him, that is up to them. He himself does not get seriously involved with girls but goes from one superficial beauty to another. When a girl writes him because she wants more from her best friend the mission is his, at the same time he himself is suddenly attracted by his best female friend, but for him love means suffering and he does not want to hurt his friend Aspen. Will he be able to overcome himself? Will the Hook-up Doctor accept to be hooked up? The story is fun, well written, has nice characters and is overall sweet and tries even to have a real depth by Sebastian having to overcome his fears. It is a quick easy read with only about 140 pages. But somehow even if the book is not bad I did not get into it, not really. I knew to fast what would happen next and everything seemed somehow fake, I was never afraid if the two would get together I just thought... oh no how stupid and how realistic. Now I am not sure I want something like that when I read a book. My final opinion is that this is a young adult book and that I am probably too old for it. It is a nice read but not a hook-up. Like Sebastian it knows how to get you (especially the nice cover) but does not guarantee to keep you.
