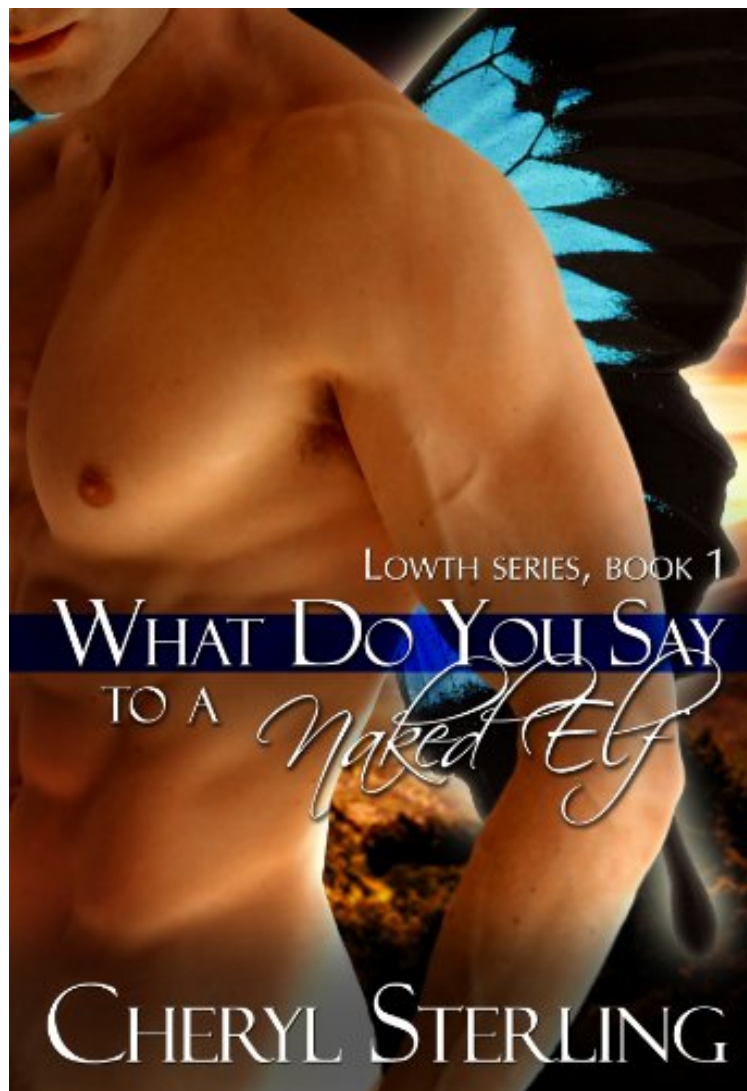

Although the cover is sorrily reminding of a comic, dont't let yourselves be led astray - this is a very good and creative story about the alternative and magical world of lowth. Our heroine jane stumbles into it by running over a bunny and being charged for murder. Our hero finds himself apointed her layer and stuck with the -in his eyes -very strangely behaving mortal. We enter lowth and start to discover its secrets. A wonderful world indeed, the stuff of fairy tales, literally. What got me hooked from the start are the surprises and the funny clash of cultures our hero and heroine face with each other. Jane is dropped into an alternative world but although magic and different culture sometimes make her head spin she holds her own. And than there is the fact that our hero has some wonderful wings hidden in his shirt.. and who would have thought touching them becomes a very sensual encounter for both participants?
