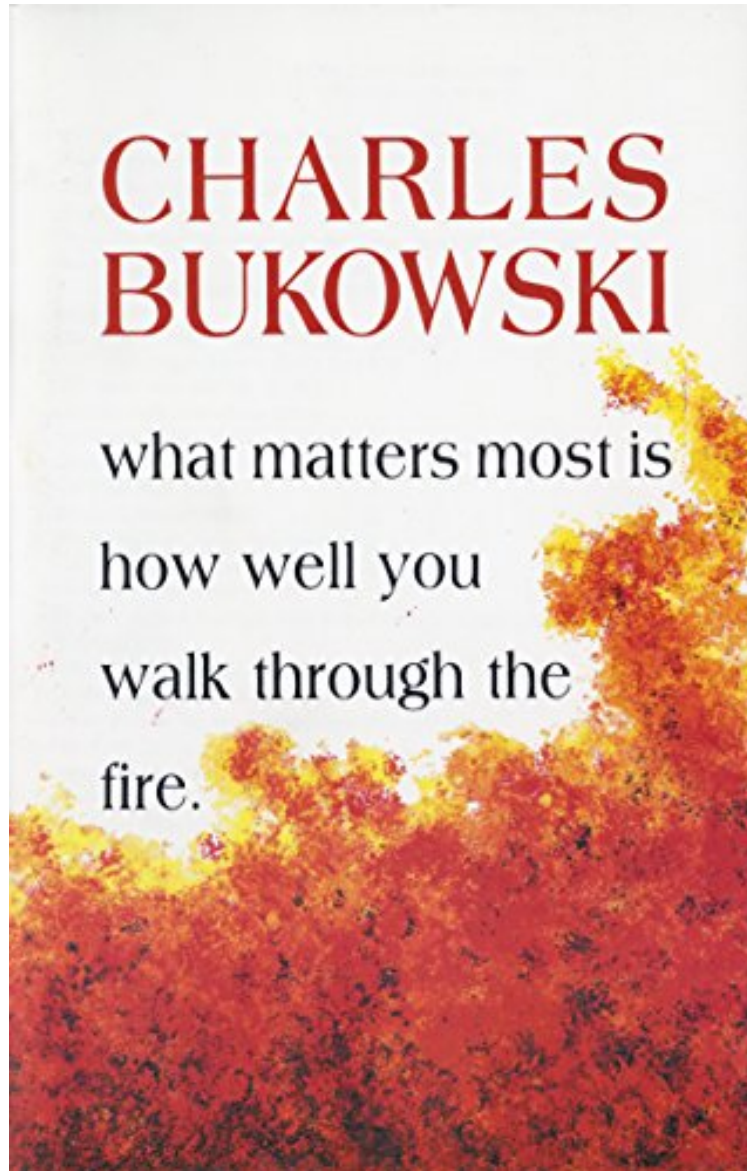

I've personally been slightly let down in recent years by the books which have come out of Bukowski's. (he
died in 1994). I picked up this collection half expecting more of the same. Didn't Bukowski himself insist that some of
his work was not-so-great? Well, this collection was a delight and a surprise! Most of these poems are from the early
1970's when Bukowski lived in East Hollywood. In these poems, (which have never been published until now) he belts
out hymns to the outsiders, the lost, the cheated and the ignored. He trains his eye on the poor and the underdog. I
