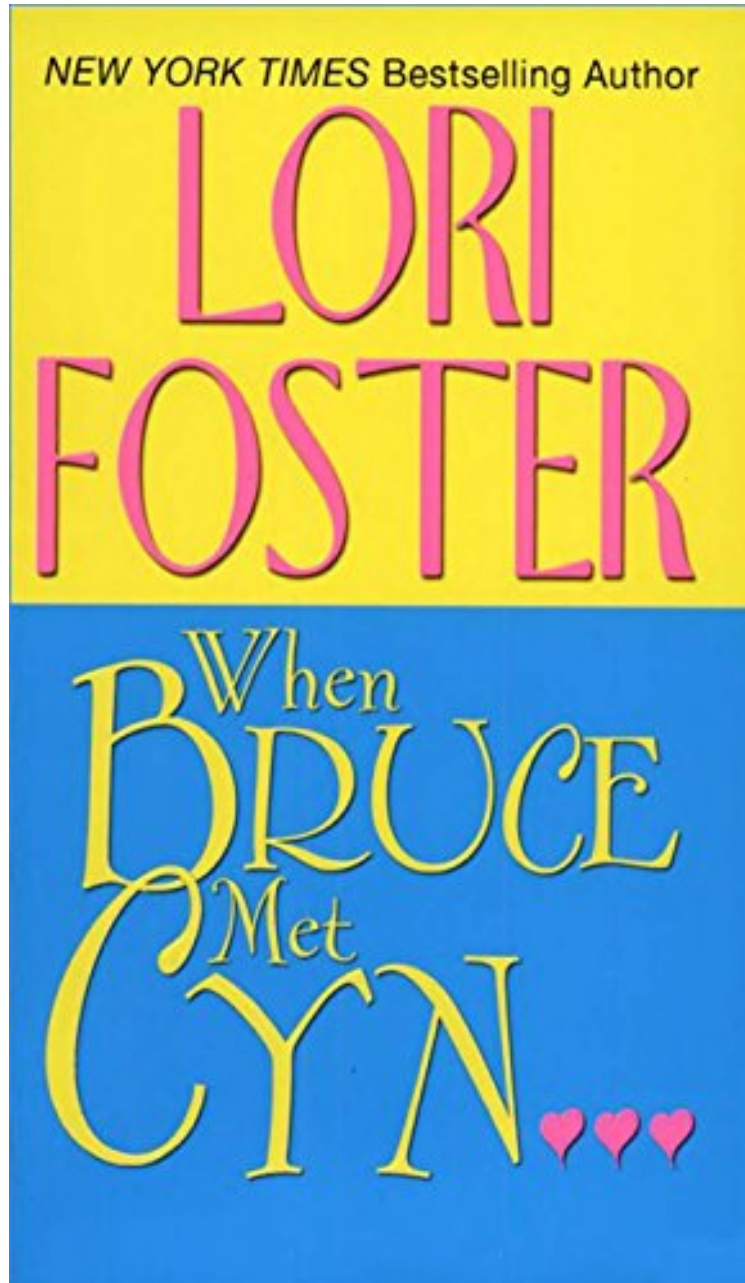

The story is more romantic than sexy, Bruce can reign his temper better than for example Joe. I am a little tired of these super gorgeous and incredibly good looking characters Lori Foster creates, but I think this is normal for romance stories. Bruce is handsome and well muscled (don't know where this comes from, maybe from distributing altar bread during Lord's Supper)and Cyn is a beautiful young woman with a gorgeous body and long black hair and blue eyes (it goes without saying that she never checks her weight, never exercises and has this thing of big breasts and slim body going on without doing anything for it).
