Sometimes, the lengthy descriptions become repetitive and

give the impression of having been written as page-fillers rather than contributing anything to the story itself. It's also getting somewhat annoying that it seems to be essential to have monsters to fight that are simply absurdly tall - nothing goes under some ten metres...Also, and this is most annoying of all, Jon has not learned a single thing about editing. As in all the other books, there are always words missing (or appearing in the wrong place), to say nothing of the arbitrary setting of commas. Sometimes, the apostrophe also seems to be a somewhat hazy concept to him - "its" and "it's" being just one example. The silliest error, though, appeared in book three, where it was "Hade's" something or other - twice on one page! Such things should simply not happen - there is a lot of fanfiction that is edited MUCH better!
